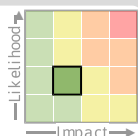

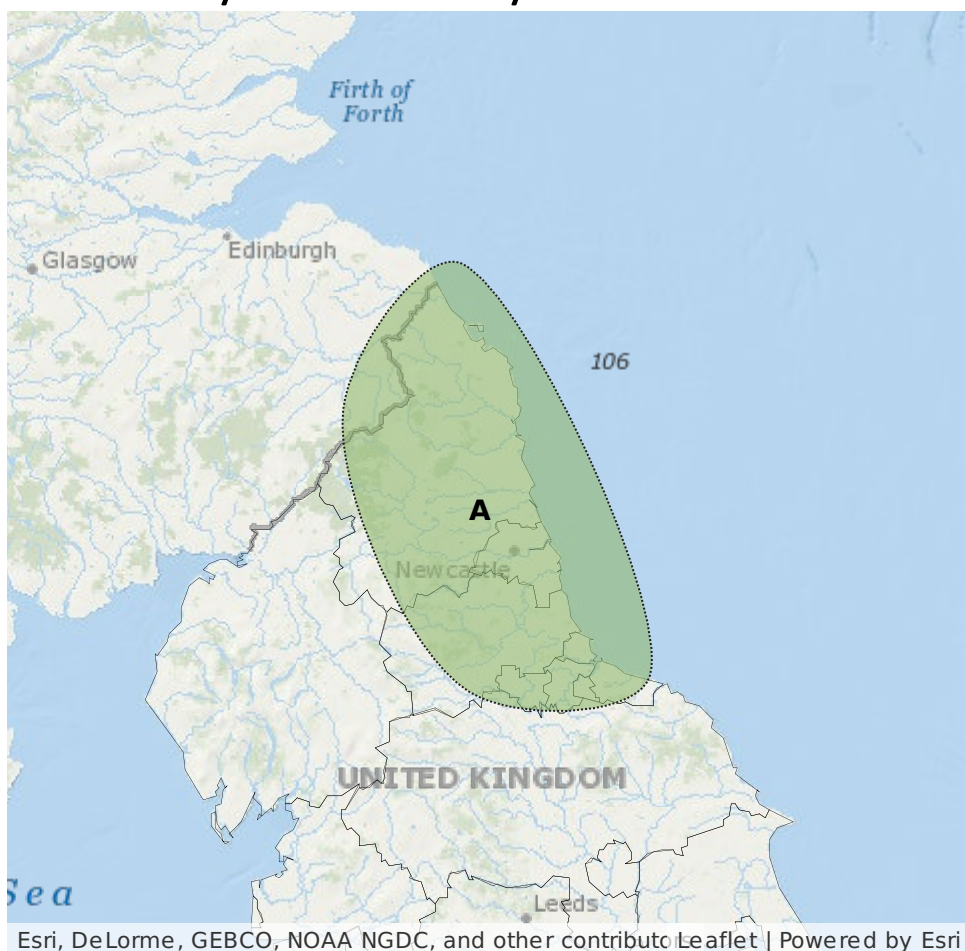

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Further rain across parts of the Pennines today is expected to keep river levels high following recent heavy rain here. However, any impacts are expected to be minimal.

This rain also brings a very low likelihood of minor impacts across the south of England and Wales.

On Wednesday and Thursday, potentially heavy and slow moving bands of showery rain could lead to some localised minor impacts, most probably across parts of north-east England, though confidence is low.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

On Wednesday and Thursday, potentially heavy and slow moving bands of showery rain could lead to some localised minor impacts, most probably across parts of north-east England, though confidence is low.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
