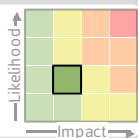

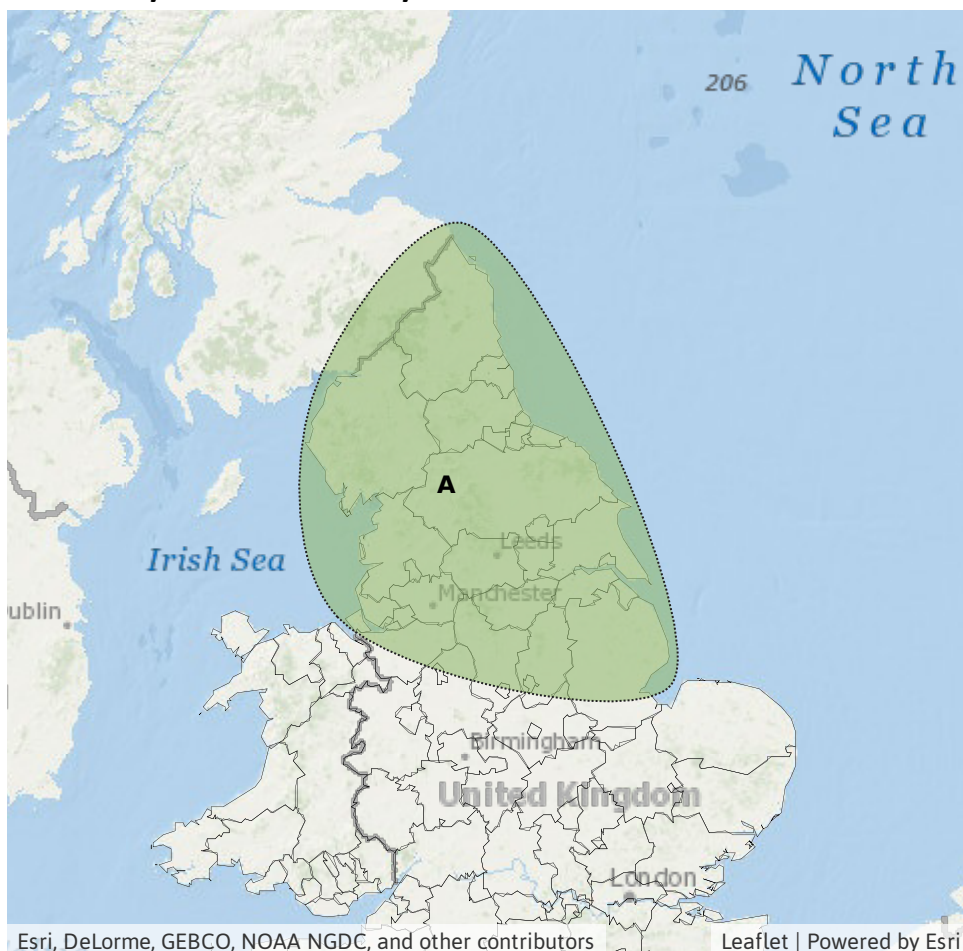

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

Localised minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of the north of England on Wednesday and into early Thursday from heavy and thundery rain. Refer to Specific Area of Concern Map 1.

Isolated minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of Wales, central, eastern and northern England today (Monday), and again on Tuesday in parts of south Wales, south west and central England. There is the potential for isolated heavy thunderstorms to develop during the afternoons and evenings. Urban areas are most at risk.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
