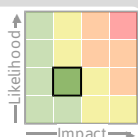

Wednesday only. Small catchments and urban areas most at risk.

Impact **MINOR**

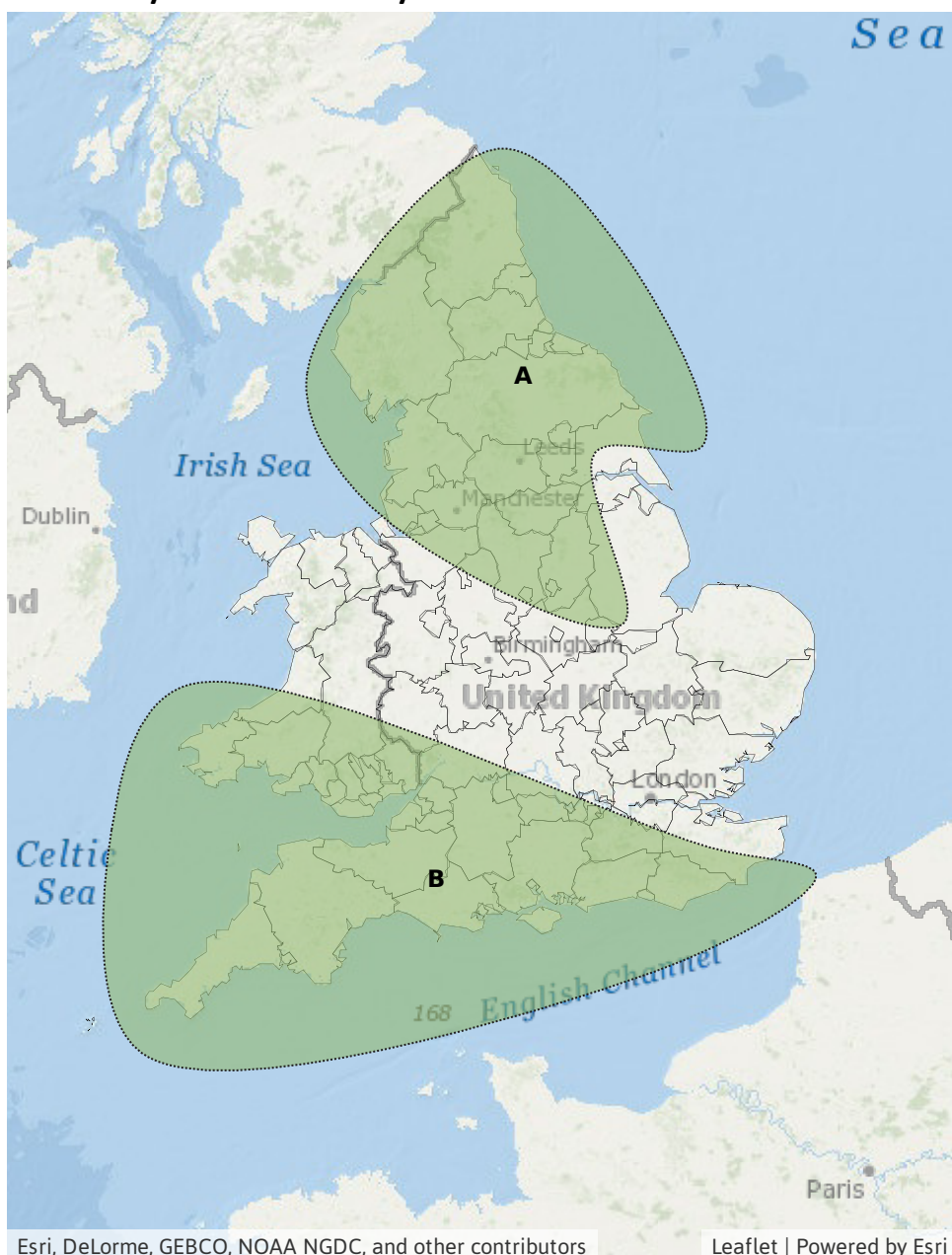

Wednesday and Thursday. Showery outbreaks of rain. Urban areas most at risk.

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Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible on Wednesday and Thursday. Refer to Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

On Friday further minor impacts are possible, but not expected, across parts of Wales and the south west of England.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible on Wednesday and Thursday. Refer to Specific Areas of Concern Map 1. These are more likely in small catchments and urban water courses.

On Friday further minor impacts are possible, but not expected, across parts of Wales and the south west of England.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days despite some large waves affecting the north-east coast of England later today (Wednesday) and into tomorrow morning.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
