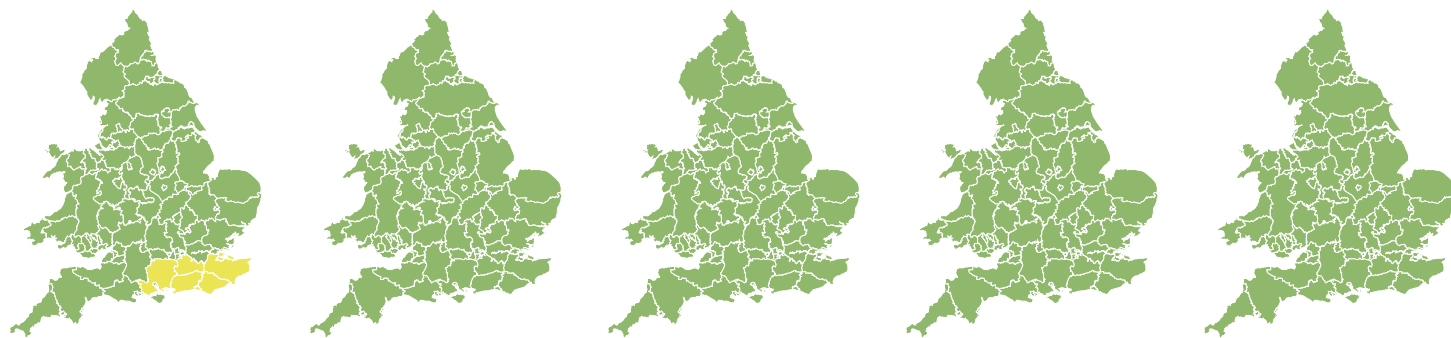

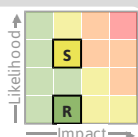
The overall flood risk is LOW today (Friday). In parts of south-east England today, minor surface water flooding impacts are probable and minor river flooding impacts are possible, but not expected.

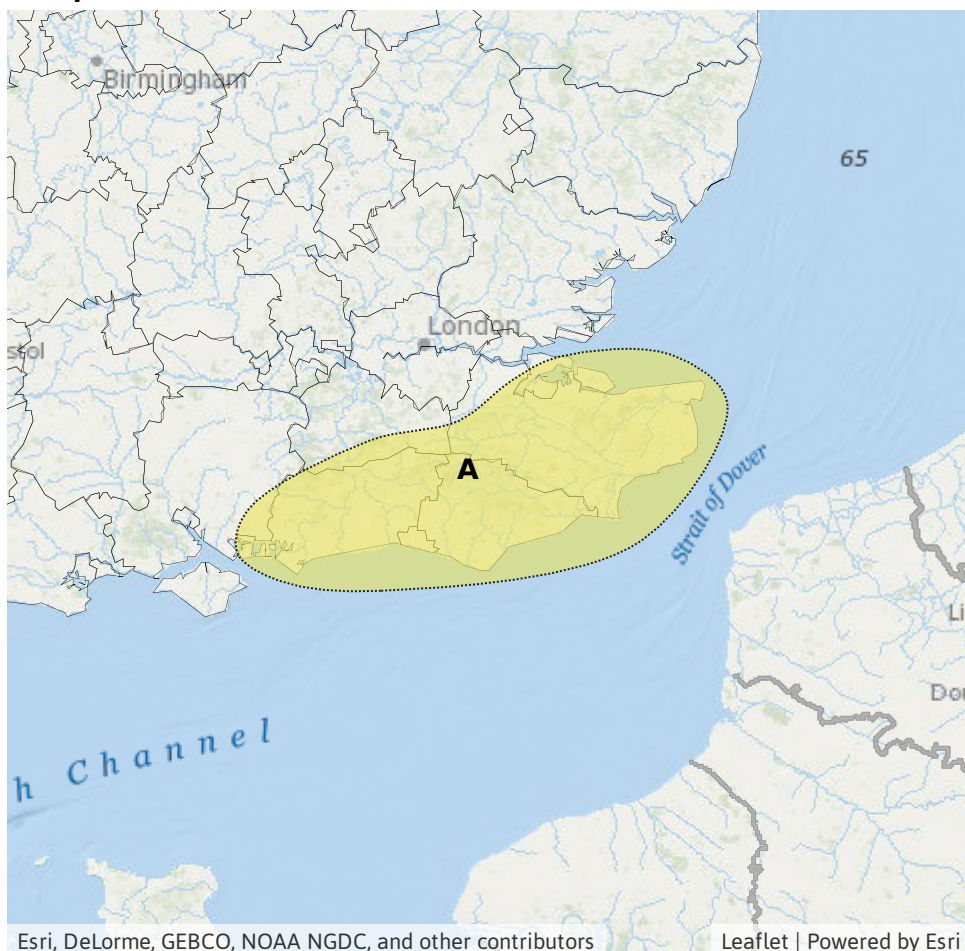
Likelihood **MEDIUM**



Source River Surface

Likely duration 1 Day

Slow moving, thunderstorms or heavy showers from mid morning to mid afternoon.

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Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Friday).

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable on Friday in parts of south-east England. Refer to Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

In the remainder of south-east England, the Midlands and East Anglia today, minor surface water flooding impacts are possible, but not expected.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible, but not expected, today in parts of south-east England. Refer to Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
