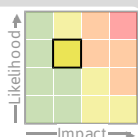
Minor surface water and river flooding impacts are probable across parts of south-east England and East Anglia today.

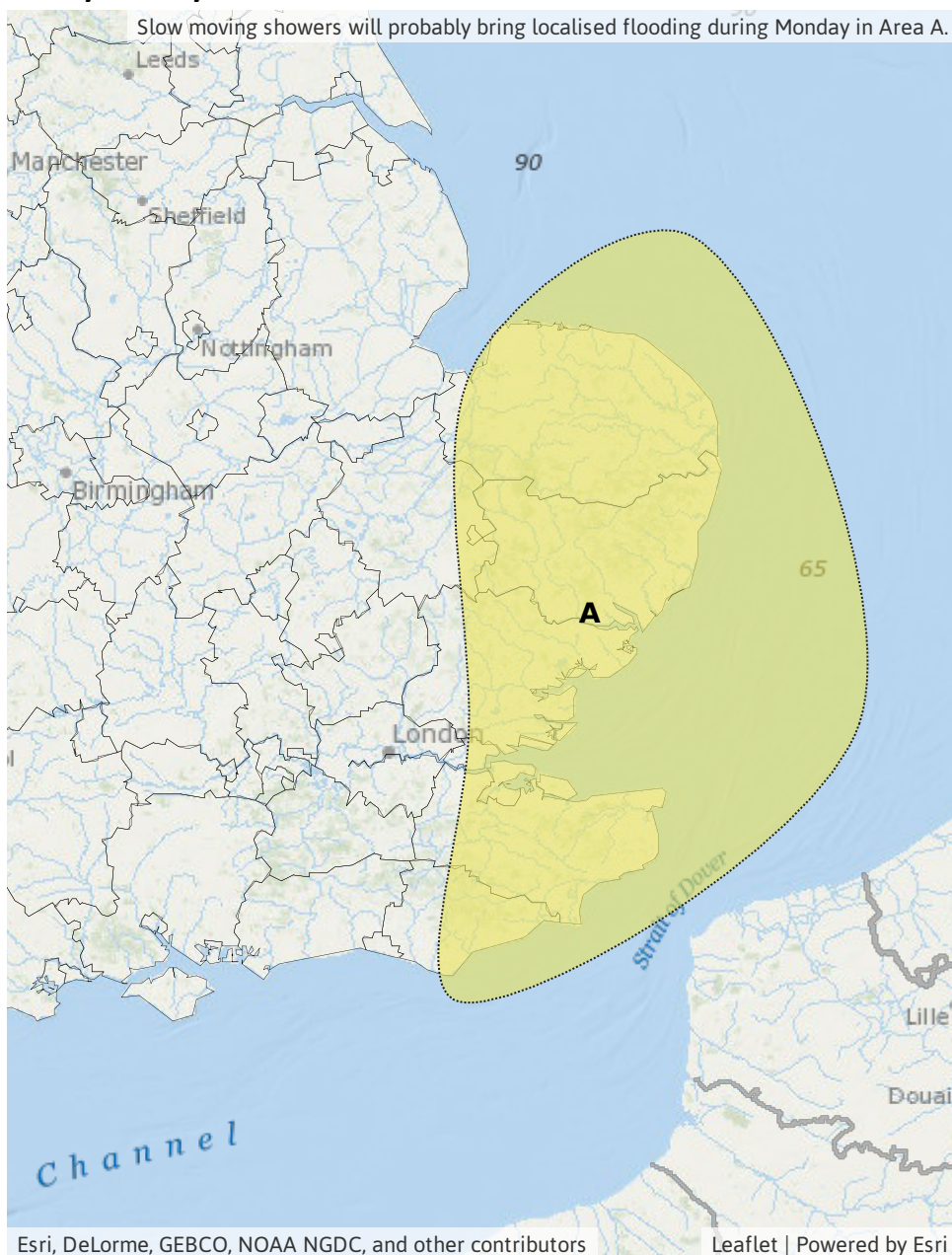

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Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Monday) and VERY LOW for the following 4 days.

Local minor surface water flooding impacts are probable today in Area A in Specific Area of Concern Map 1. This is due to heavy, thundery showers which are most likely in the daytime. Urban areas are most at risk.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible but not expected later on Tuesday and into Wednesday across southern parts of England and Wales, due to widespread, locally heavy rain. Urban areas are most at risk.



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW today (Monday) and VERY LOW for the following 4 days.

Local minor river flooding impacts are probable today in Area A in Specific Area of Concern Map 1. This is due to heavy, thundery showers, which are most likely during the daytime. Fast responding urban catchments are most at risk.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected later on Tuesday and into Wednesday across southern parts of England and Wales, due to widespread, locally heavy rain. Small catchments in urban areas are most at risk.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
