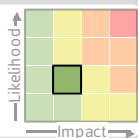

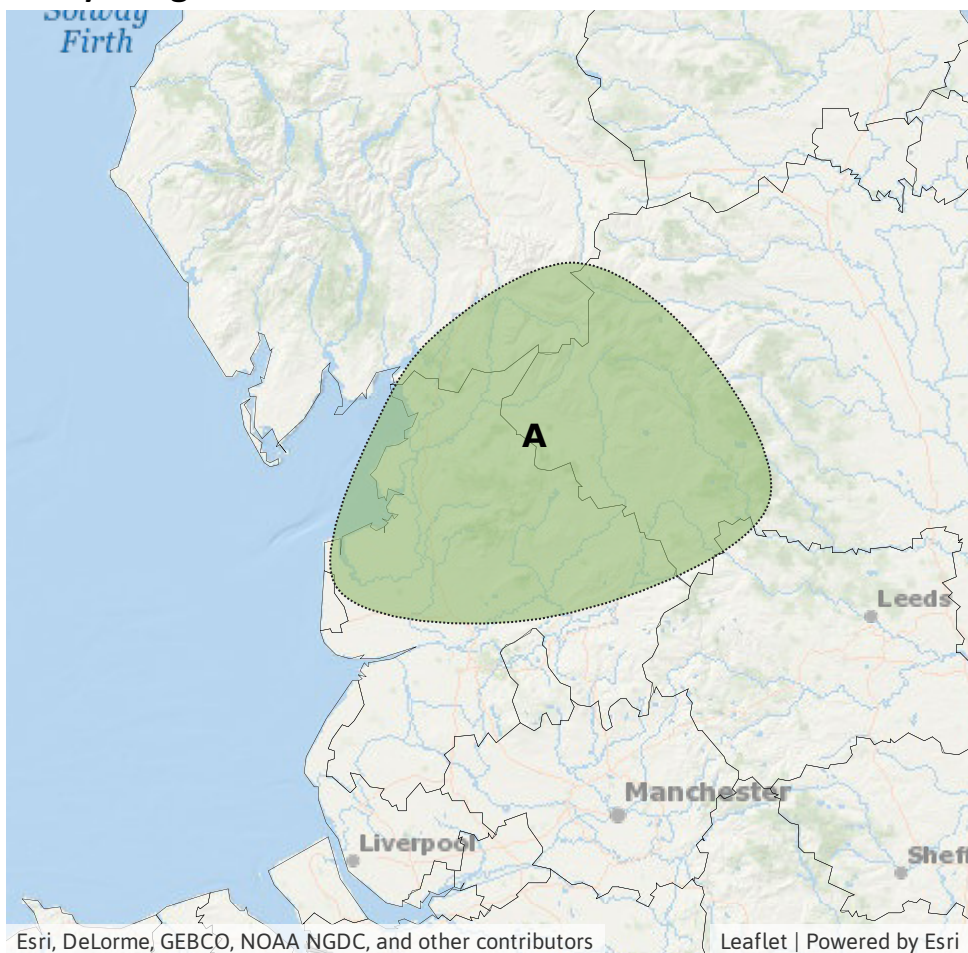

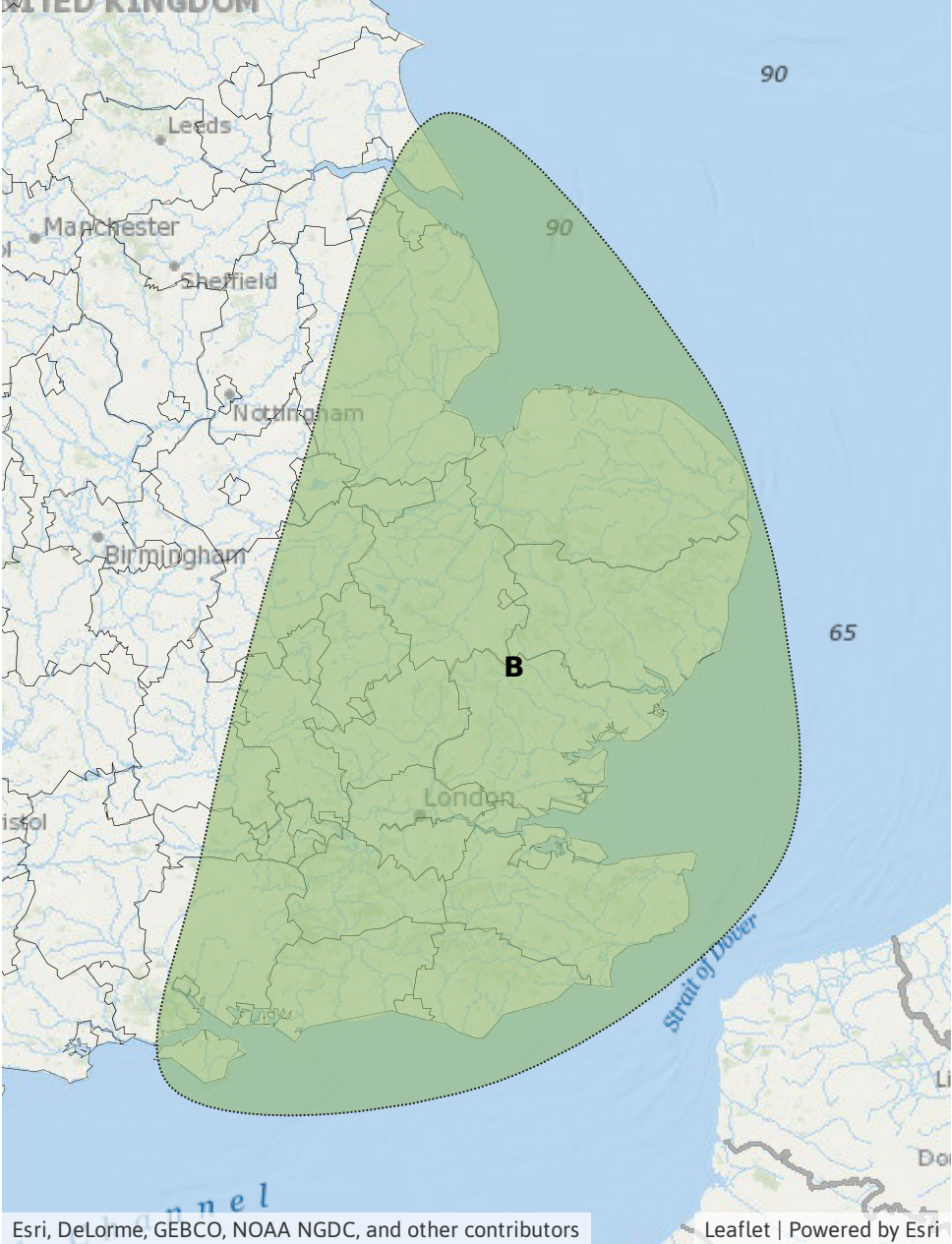

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

Isolated minor river flooding impacts are possible in Area A on Specific Area of Concern Map 1 from the early hours of Monday morning, as a result of heavy rain on Sunday evening and overnight into Monday. Small catchments are most at risk.

Isolated minor river flooding impacts are also possible in Area B on Specific Area of Concern Map 2 on Tuesday and Wednesday but this risk is restricted to small, urban watercourses.

The river flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.



Surface water

Isolated minor surface water flooding impacts are possible in Area B in Specific Area of Concern Map 2 on Tuesday and Wednesday due to a risk of heavy, thundery showers. On both days, impacts are most likely during the afternoon and early evening. Urban areas are most at risk.

The surface water flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
