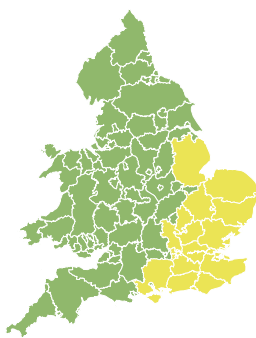

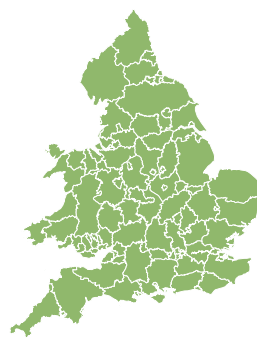

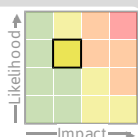
Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable on Tuesday and on Wednesday in the south-east of England. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Impact **MINOR**

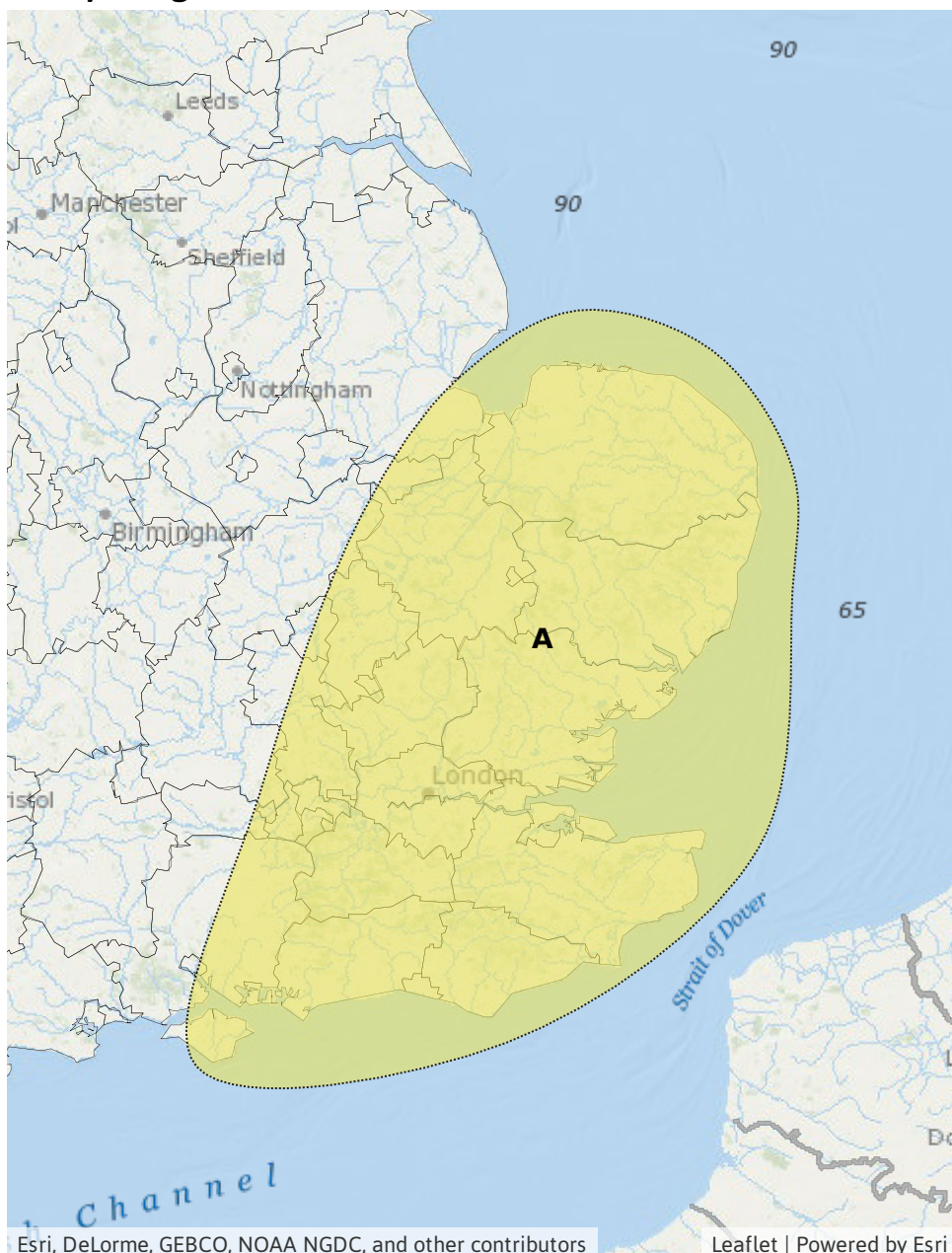
Likelihood **MEDIUM**

Urban areas most at risk in afternoon/evening. Not all areas will be affected.



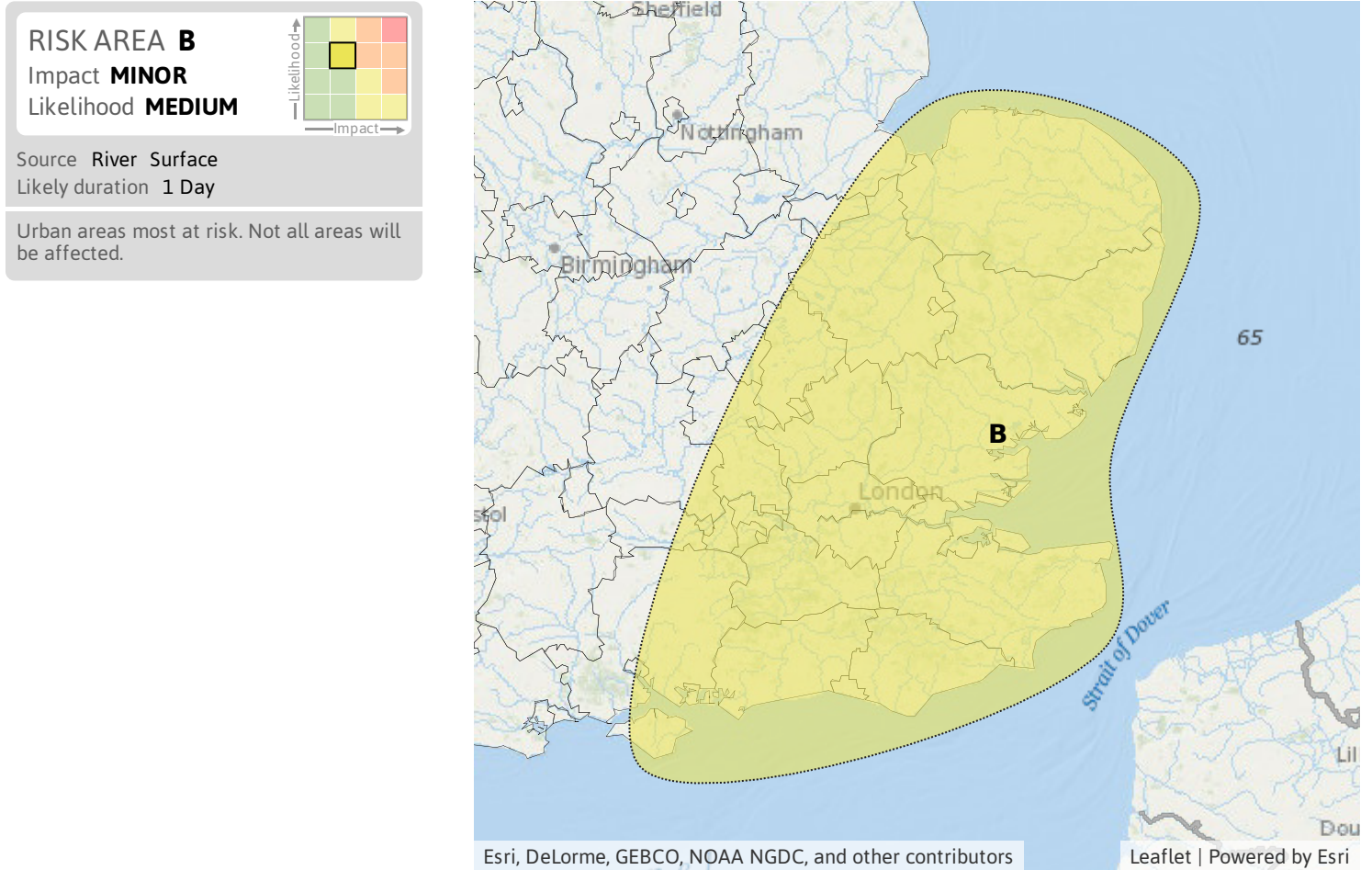

Specific Area of Concern Map 2: Wednesday 9 August



Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

Isolated minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in Area A in Specific Area of Concern Map 1 on Tuesday due to a risk of heavy, thundery showers. Minor impacts are also probable in Area B in Specific Area of Concern Map 2 on Wednesday.

Elsewhere, despite further showers, the surface water flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.



Rivers

Isolated minor river flooding impacts are probable in Area A on Specific Area of Concern Map 1 on Tuesday and in Area B on Map 2 on Wednesday. However, this risk is restricted to small, urban watercourses.

Elsewhere, the river flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
