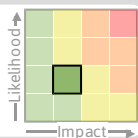
Minor surface water and river flooding impacts are possible but not expected today (Monday) in western parts of England. Further minor impacts are also possible on Tuesday night into Wednesday across parts of the north of England.

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected today (Monday) in western parts of England in response to locally heavy showers. Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible on Tuesday night into Wednesday in the north of England in response to widespread rainfall - see Specific Area of Concern Map 1. Any flooding may be exacerbated by wind-blown debris blocking drains.

The overall surface water flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.



Rivers

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected today (Monday) in western parts of England in response to locally heavy showers falling onto already wet catchments. Minor river flooding impacts are also possible across the north of England on Tuesday night and Wednesday due to more widespread rainfall. Smaller, faster responding rivers and urban watercourses are more prone.

The overall river flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

The overall coastal/tidal flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days despite periods of strong winds and large waves at times today (Monday) and on Tuesday.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
