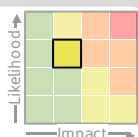
Minor river and surface water flooding impacts are probable through parts of the north of England this (Tuesday) evening and overnight into Wednesday morning.

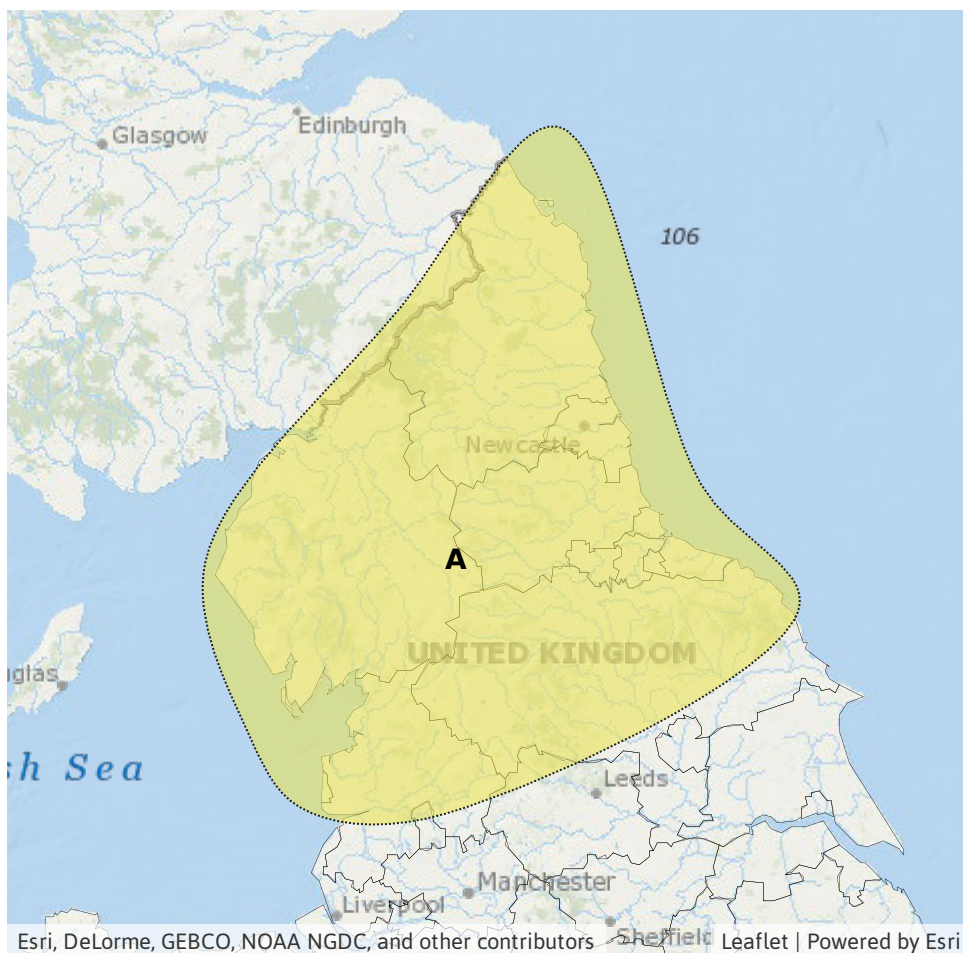

Small, fast responding rivers and urban areas most susceptible.



Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable this (Tuesday) evening and overnight into Wednesday morning in Area A in Specific Area of Concern Map 1, as a result of widespread and locally heavy rain. Any flooding may be exacerbated by wind-blown debris blocking drains.



Rivers

Minor river flooding impacts are probable overnight into Wednesday morning in Area A in Specific Area of Concern Map 1, as a result of widespread and locally heavy rain. Any flooding may be exacerbated by wind-blown debris blocking screens in urban watercourses. Smaller rivers and urban watercourses are most at risk.



Coastal/Tidal

The overall coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days. Gale force winds this (Tuesday) evening and overnight may generate large waves and spray for exposed coastal locations along parts of the south and west coasts of England and all Welsh coasts. Despite this, only minimal impacts are expected.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
