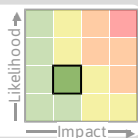
Minor river and surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across the north of England and Wales on Wednesday night. Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible on Thursday and Friday. The flood risk is VERY LOW.

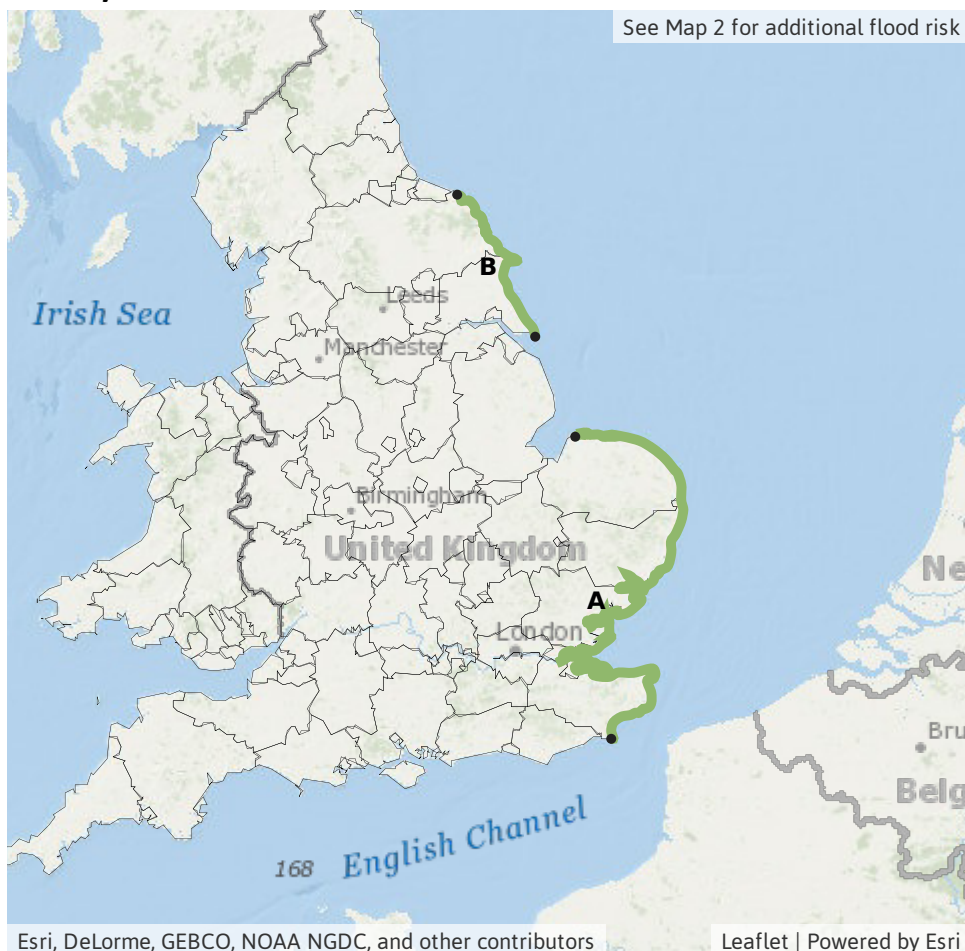

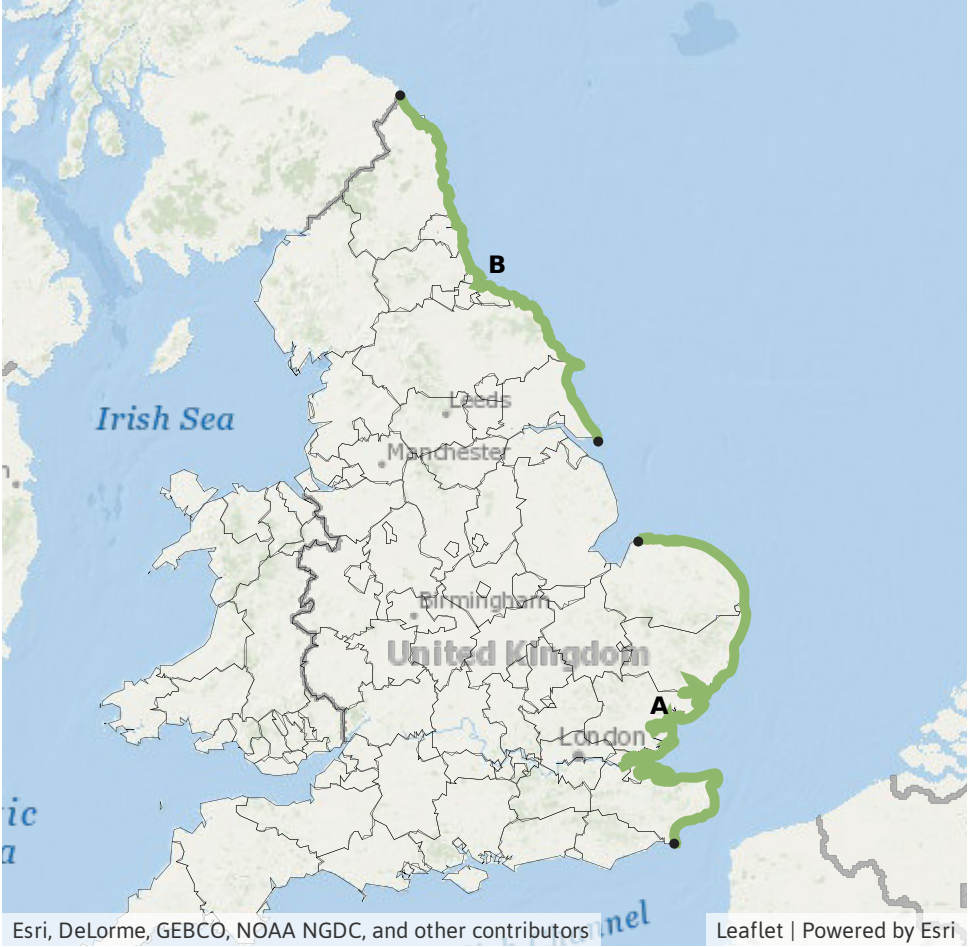

Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Strong winds over the North Sea on Thursday and Friday will bring large waves and some surge to the east coast of England. Local minor coastal flood impacts are possible around some North Sea ports along the east coast of England (as shown by Areas A and B in Specific Areas of concern Maps 1 and 2). This risk is particularly around times of high water on Thursday afternoon and on Friday.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected due to heavy rain on Wednesday afternoon and overnight into Thursday morning across the north of England and north Wales.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected due to heavy rain on Wednesday afternoon and overnight into Thursday morning across the north of England and north Wales.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
