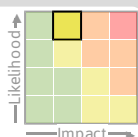
Minor river flood impacts are expected around the River Ouse in York on Thursday and Friday, leading to a LOW river flood risk here.

Impact **MINOR**

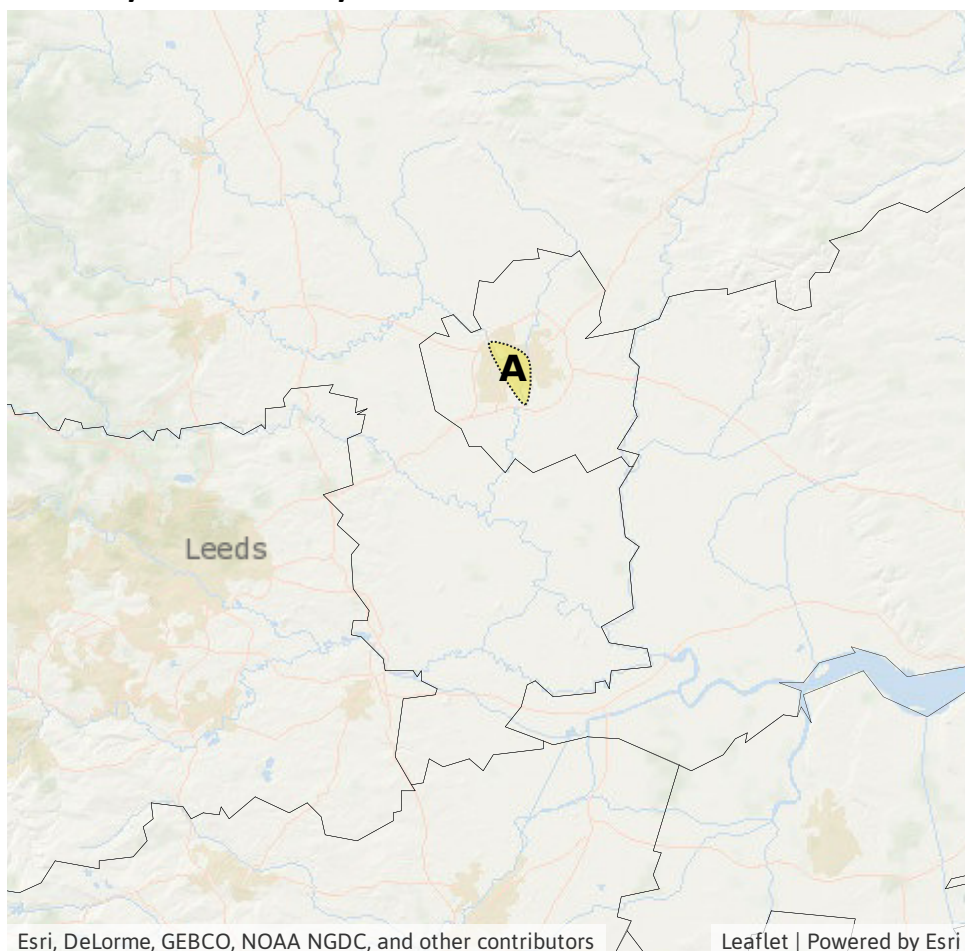

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Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

River levels are now generally falling across the north and west of England and Wales after Wednesday's heavy rainfall. However, minor river flood impacts are expected in York on Thursday and Friday as the River Ouse continues to rise. This leads to a LOW river flood risk for York (as shown as Areas A in Specific Area of Concern Map 1), reducing to a VERY LOW river flood risk from Saturday.

Elsewhere the river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Surface water

On Thursday local surface water flooding is expected to continue to affect parts of the north and west of England and Wales after Wednesday's heavy rainfall. However, impacts are expected to be minimal and the surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
