Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Strong winds and large waves may lead to some wind blown spray and overtopping locally along the Yorkshire coast today (Thursday) and during Friday morning. However, only minimal impacts are expected.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

10:30hrs Thursday 30 November 2017

There is the potential for unsettled conditions to coincide with the tail end of the high spring tide period late next week affecting parts of the North Sea coast. The situation is being monitored closely.
