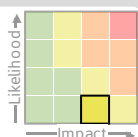

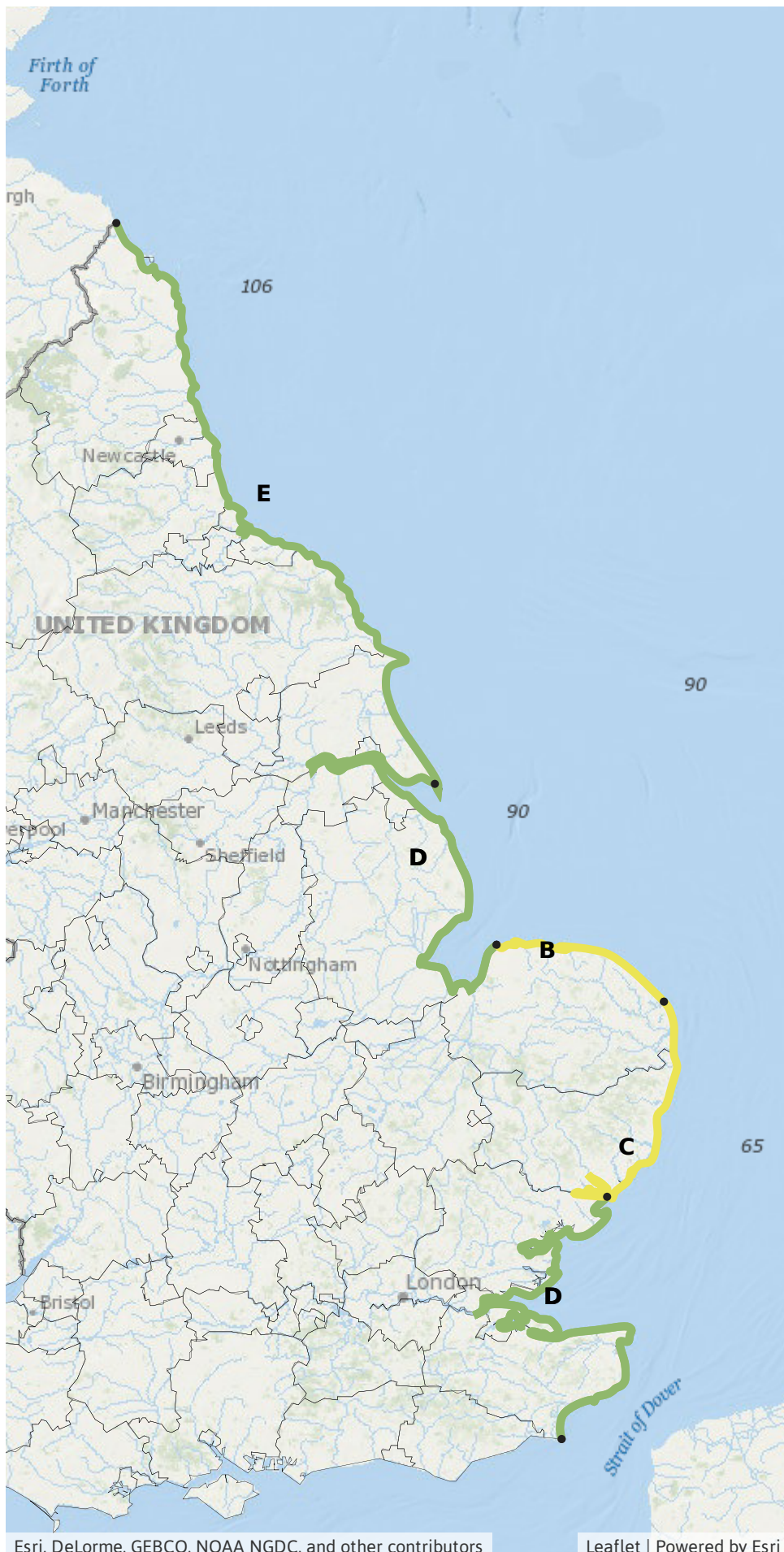

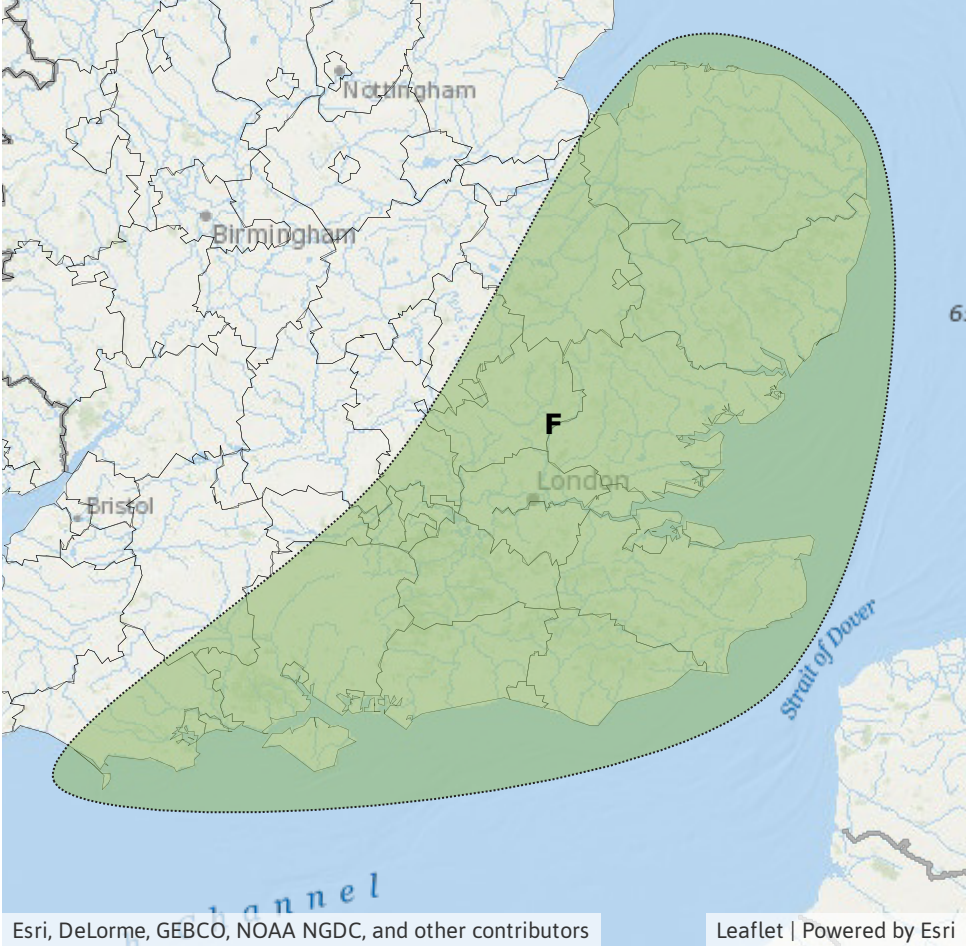

Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal flood risk is LOW on Friday and Saturday.

On Friday significant coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected along North Sea coastlines labelled A in Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

On Friday and Saturday minor coastal flooding impacts are probable along coastlines labelled B and C from high water levels and large waves, and also on the Broads due to tide locking in Norfolk and Suffolk, in the Specific Areas of Concern Maps 1 and 2.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible on Friday and Saturday along coastlines labelled D (particularly in the Humber estuary) as shown in the Specific Areas of Concern Maps 1 and 2.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible on Saturday for parts of the northeast coast of England due to large, powerful waves as shown in coastline labelled E in Specific Areas of Concern Map 2.

Any impacts will result from the effects of a deep area of low pressure which brings the potential for strong winds, a positive surge and large waves to parts of the east coast of England during this period.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected for the south coasts of both England and Wales on Sunday due to very strong westerly winds and large waves.



Surface water

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible on Monday in Area F in Specific Area of Concern Map 3, due to heavy rain and strong winds.

The overall surface water flood risk remains VERY LOW.



Rivers

Minor river flooding impacts are possible on Monday (and may last into Tuesday) in Area F in Specific Area of Concern Map 3, due to heavy rain. Small, fast responding urban catchments are most at risk.

The overall river flood risk remains VERY LOW.



Groundwater

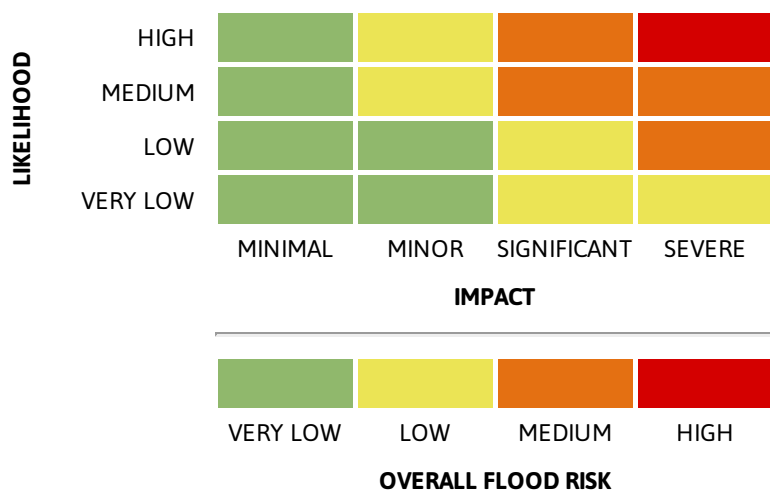
The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
 Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
 Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
