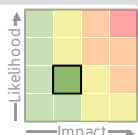
Minor river and surface water flooding impacts are possible on Wednesday into early Thursday in parts of Wales and central England.

RISK AREA A

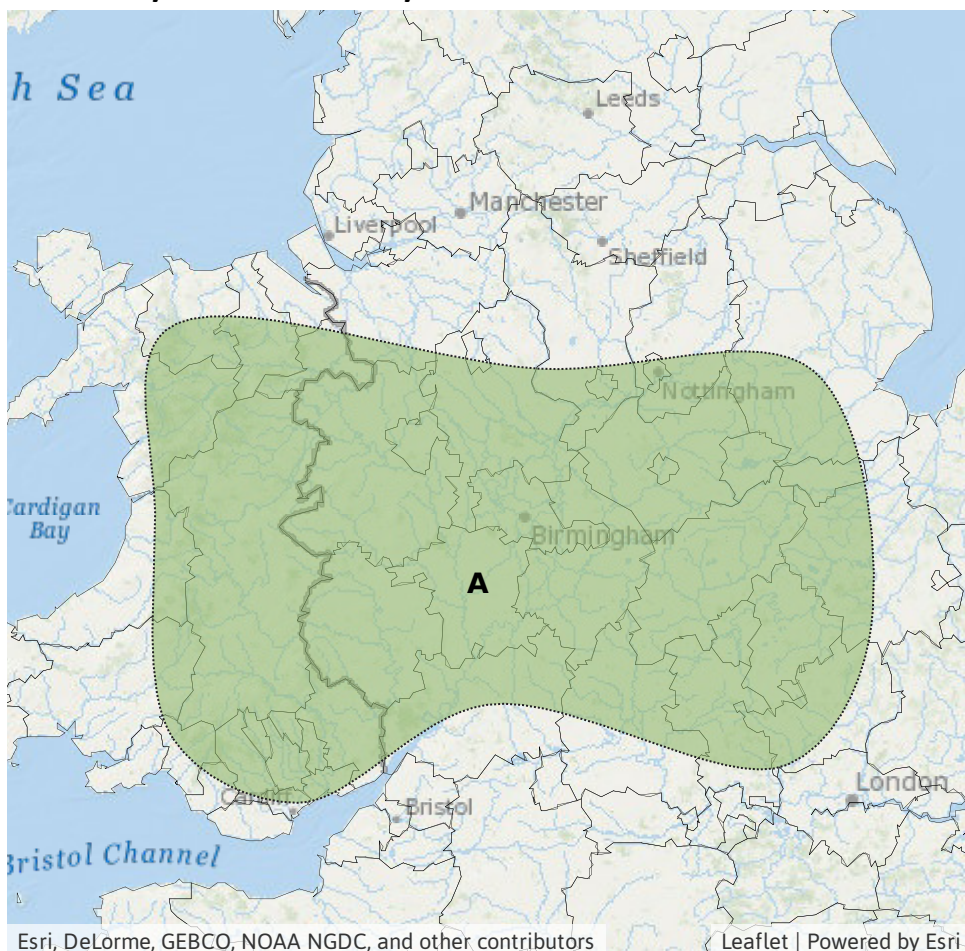

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of south-east England and East Anglia today (Monday) due to heavy rain and strong winds. Wind blown debris may also impede drainage in places.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible on Wednesday into Thursday in Area A in Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 due to a combination of rain and melting lying snow.

The overall surface water flood risk remains VERY LOW.



Rivers

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in parts of south-east England and East Anglia today (Monday) due to heavy rain. Small, fast responding urban catchments are most at risk.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible on Wednesday into Thursday in Area A in Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 due to a combination rain and melting lying snow.

The overall river flood risk remains VERY LOW.



Coastal/Tidal

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected, due to gale force winds and large waves for the south-east coast of England today (Monday) and the far south-west of England from Wednesday through to Friday.

The coastal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
