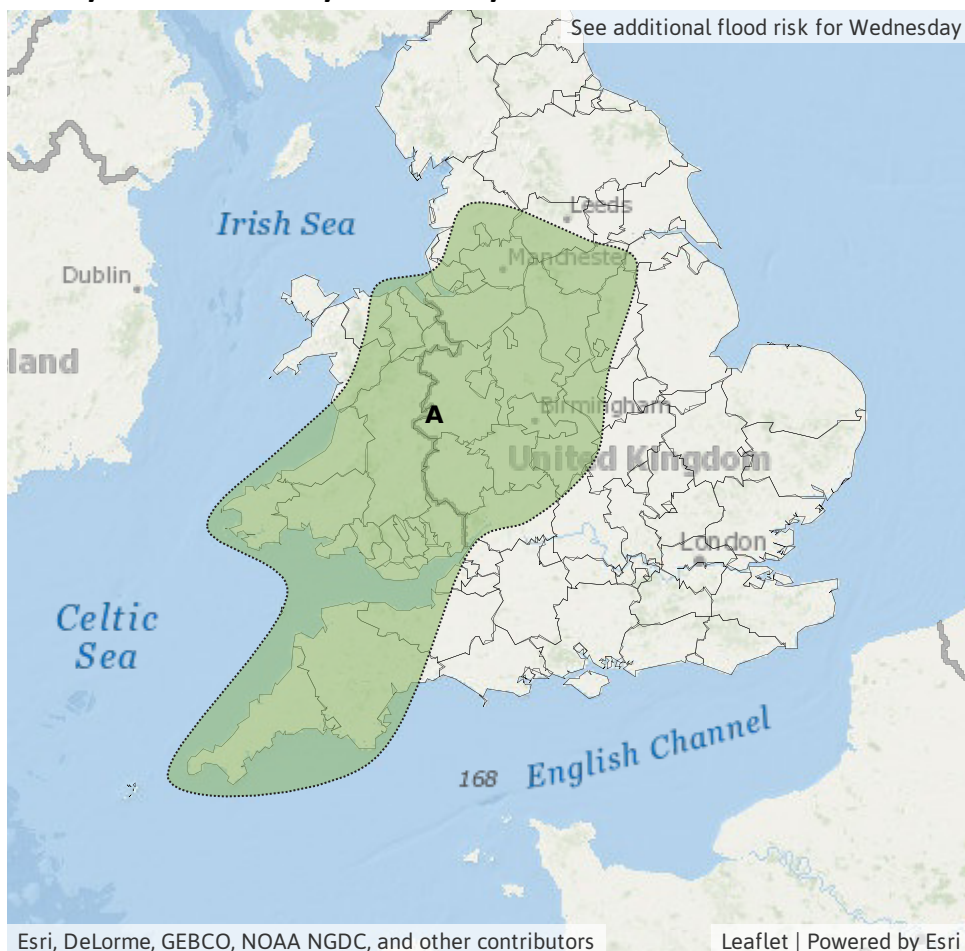

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The overall river flood risk is VERY LOW.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible in Area A on Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 during Sunday and Monday due to heavy rainfall falling on saturated catchments. In parts of Wales, the Midlands and the north of England this may be combined with snowmelt.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible in Area B on Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 during Wednesday as further rain falls onto sensitive catchments.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across other parts of England during this period.



Surface water

The overall surface water flood risk is VERY LOW.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible in Area A on Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 during Sunday and Monday due to heavy rain. In parts of Wales, the Midlands and the north of England this may be combined with snowmelt.

Local minor surface water flooding impacts are possible in Area B on Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 during Wednesday with further heavy rain.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across other parts of England and Wales during this period.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
