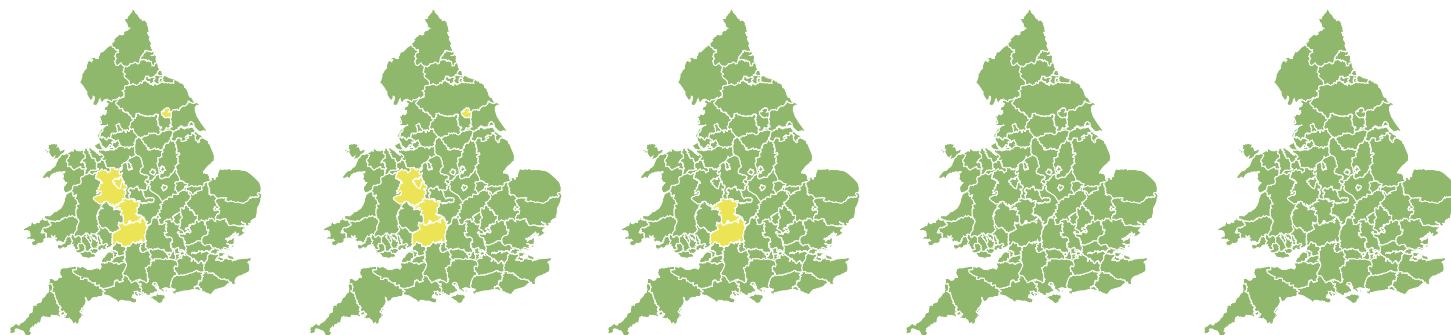

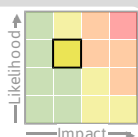

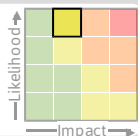
Likely duration 3 Days

Impact **MINOR**

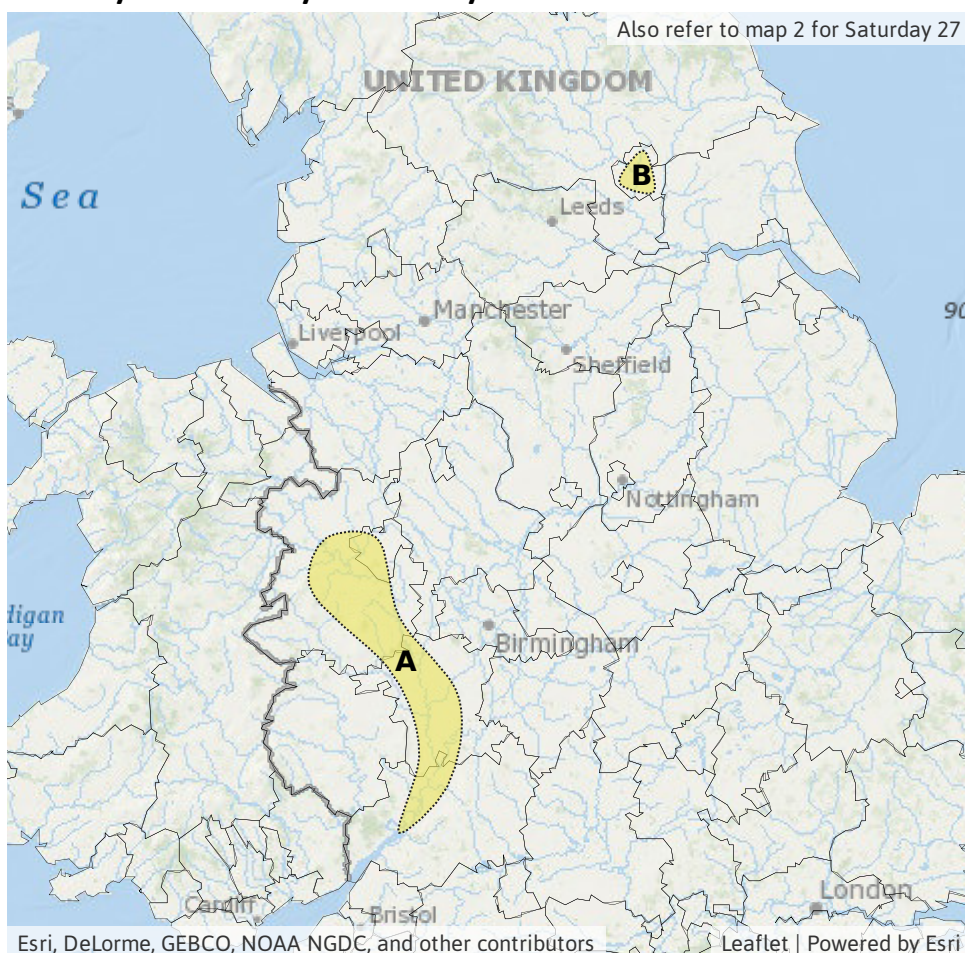
Likelihood **HIGH**

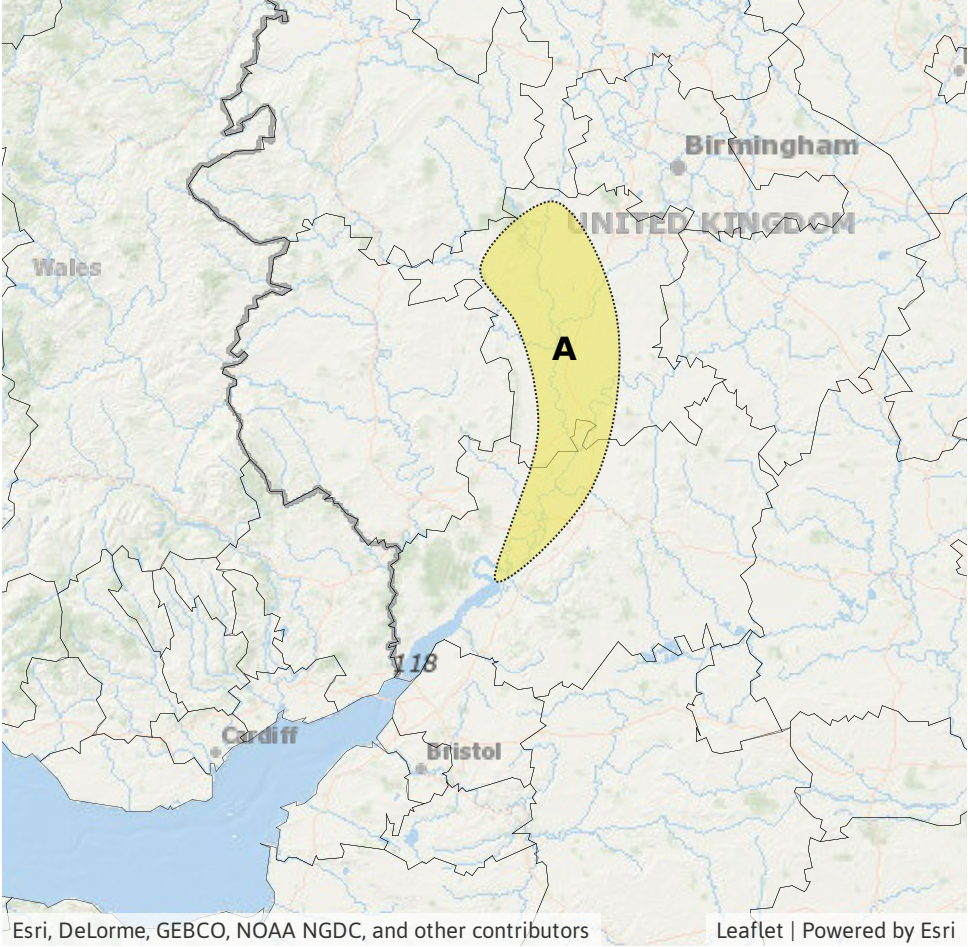

Flood impacts are probable around the River Severn on Saturday.



Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The overall river flood risk is LOW.

Minor river flooding impacts are expected around the River Ouse in York today (Thursday) and Friday - see Area B in Specific Area of Concern Map 1.

Minor river flooding impacts are probable along parts of the River Severn today, Friday and Saturday - see Area A in Specific Area of Concern Maps 1 and 2.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days, despite some large waves at times in the south-west today.



Surface water

The overall surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
