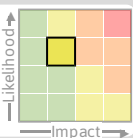
Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable for parts of the Yorkshire and Norfolk coasts on Thursday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Source Coastal/Tidal

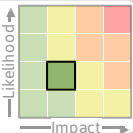
Likely duration 1 Day

Assessment of flood risk



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW for Thursday as high tides, large waves and surge combine to bring the potential for spray and wave overtopping in places. Minor coastal flooding impacts are probable along parts of the Yorkshire and Norfolk coasts, and possible for other parts of the east coast of England on Thursday. This is shown by Areas A and B on Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Localised minor coastal flooding impacts are also possible, but not expected, along other parts of the English and Welsh coastlines at times from late Wednesday to Saturday.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
