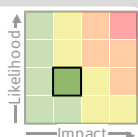
Minor surface water flood impacts are possible on Tuesday and Wednesday in the south-west of England and Wales, with minor river flood impacts possible in South Wales on Wednesday. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

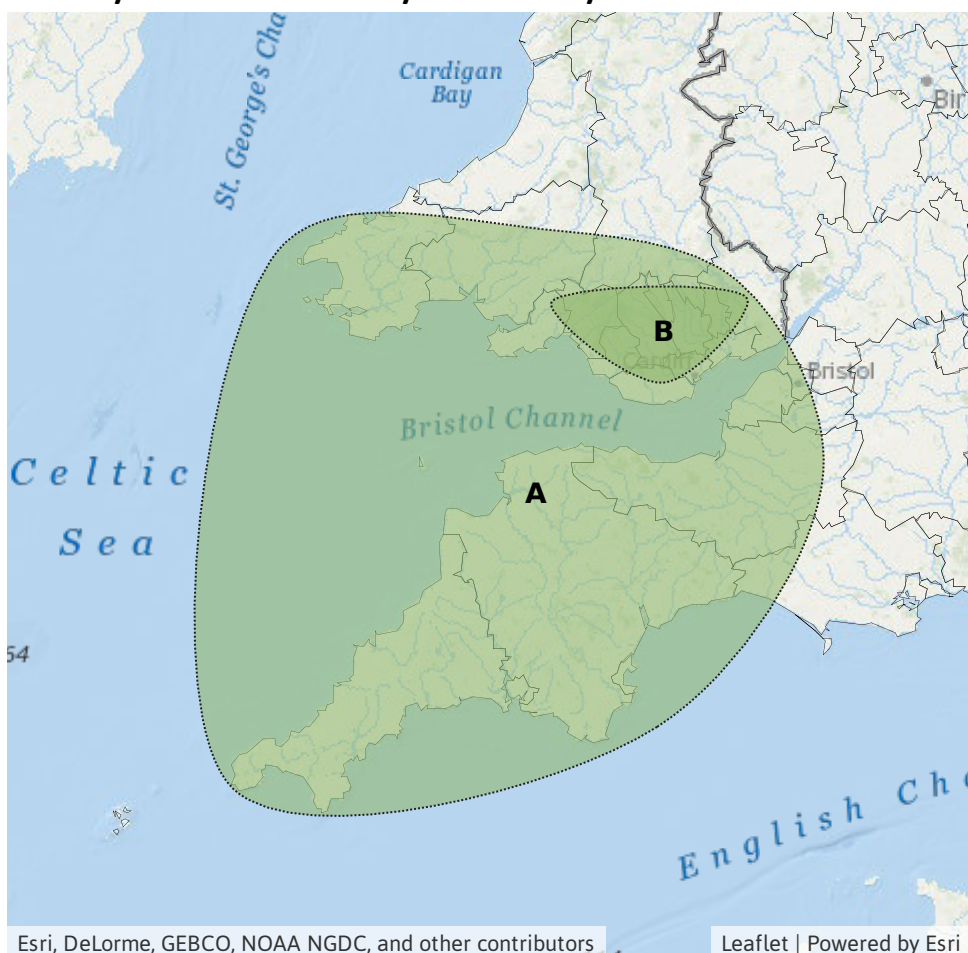

River flood impacts are mainly for fast responding catchments on Wednesday only.



Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flood impacts are possible on Tuesday and Wednesday in the south-west of both England and Wales due to spells of heavy rain. This is shown in Area A on Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Elsewhere any impacts are expected to be minimal.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

River flood impacts are possible in parts of South Wales on Wednesday due to heavy rain. This is shown in Area B on Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Elsewhere on Tuesday and Wednesday rivers may respond to heavy rain but any river flood impacts are expected to be minimal.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
