Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minimal surface water flooding impacts are possible from further rain and snowmelt today (Saturday) across the north of England.

Local minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of England and Wales later on Sunday and on Monday, due to bands of heavy and potentially slow moving showers.



Rivers

The river flood risk remains VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minimal river flooding impacts are possible from further rain and snowmelt today (Saturday) across the north of England.

Local minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of England and Wales later on Sunday and on Monday, due to bands of heavy and potentially slow moving showers.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days, despite the risk of strong winds and large waves at times.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
