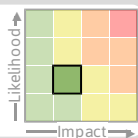
Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of central and south of England and parts of Wales today (Sunday) and on Monday. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

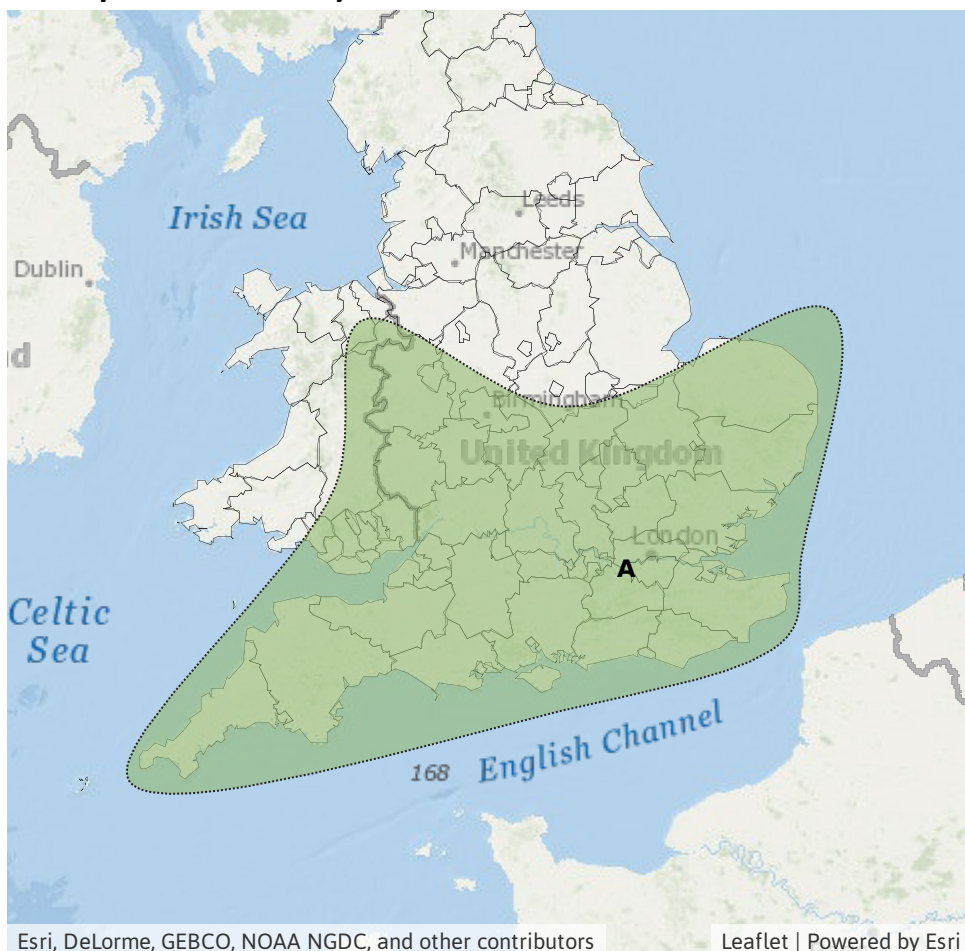

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Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Local minor surface water flooding impacts are possible in Area A of Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 and possible but not expected elsewhere across England and Wales today (Sunday) and on Monday. This is due to bands of heavy and potentially slow moving showers.

Local minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected again for parts of England and Wales on Wednesday and Thursday, due to heavy persistent rain.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Local minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of England and Wales later today (Sunday) and on Monday. This is due to bands of heavy and potentially slow moving showers.

Local minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected again for parts of England and Wales on Wednesday and Thursday, due to heavy persistent rain.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days, despite the risk of strong winds and large waves at times.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
