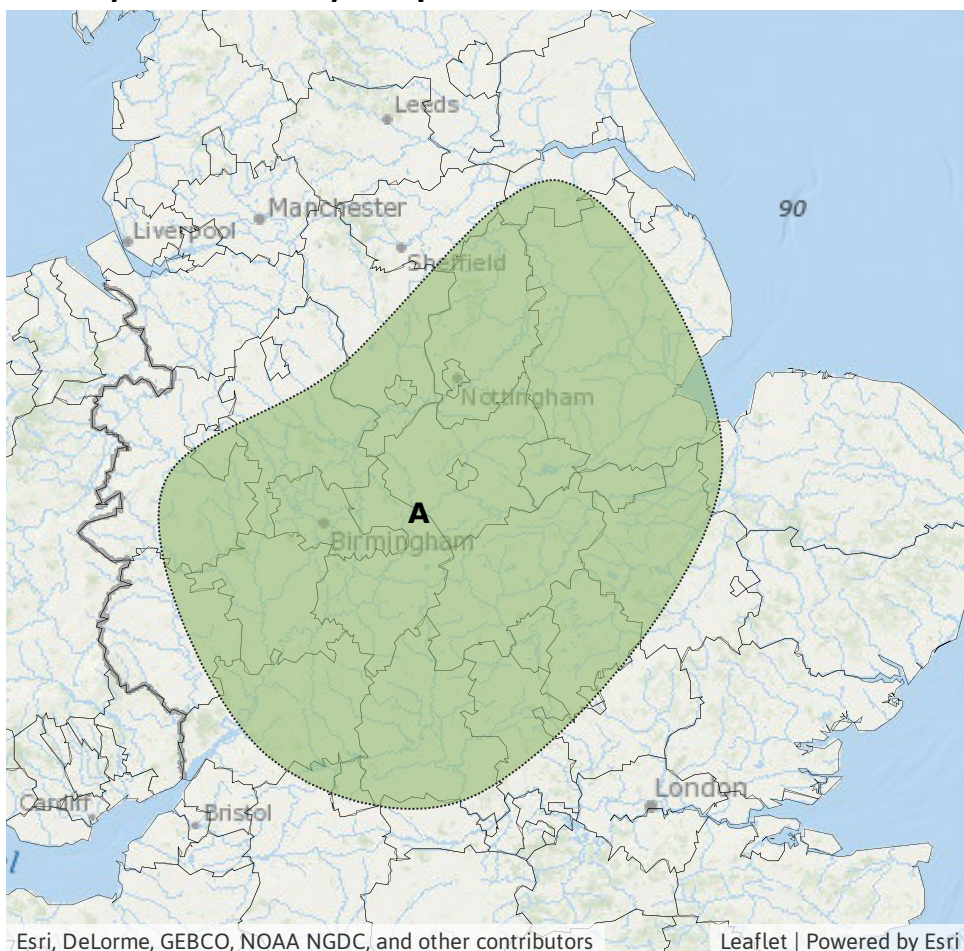

Main risk period is from Monday afternoon and on Tuesday.



Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

River catchments across much of England and Wales remain sensitive to modest amounts of rainfall. Localised minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected, especially over parts of the Midlands and the south of England later on Monday and on Tuesday.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Heavy rain or thundery showers are expected across England and Wales over the weekend and into next week and localised minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Groundwater levels are currently high across parts of Dorset, North Yorkshire and East Riding of Yorkshire and may continue to rise over the coming days. In parts of Dorset some properties may be required to run their basement pumps.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
