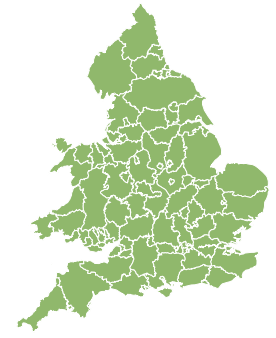


Flood Guidance Statement

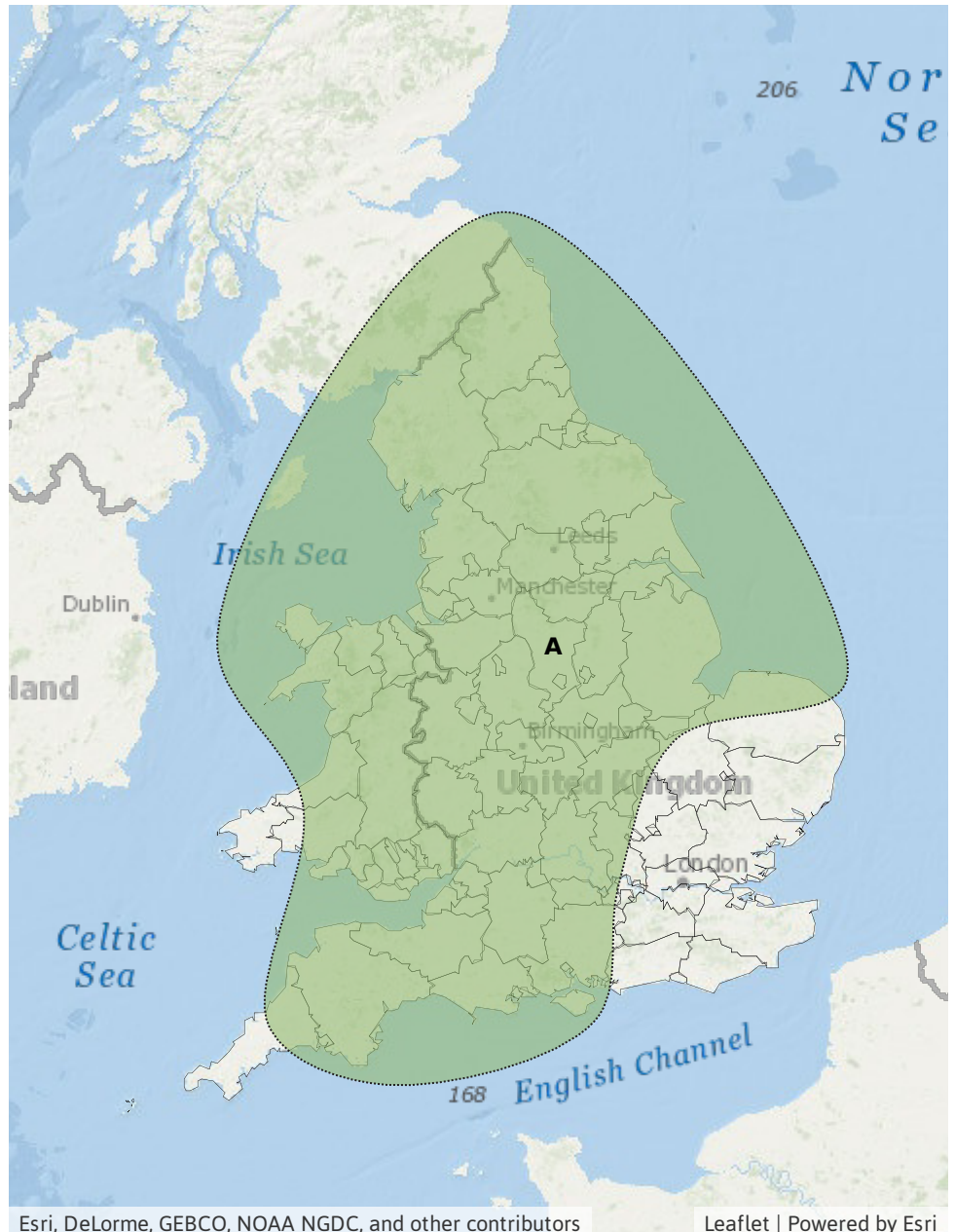
Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of England and Wales today into tomorrow morning and are possible but not expected across the north and east of England from Thursday to Saturday. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

Urban areas most at risk later Tuesday and overnight into Wednesday morning.



Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible later today (Tuesday) and into Wednesday morning as thundery showers spread north across England and Wales. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 1.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of the north and east of England during Thursday and Friday due to thundery showers, and on Saturday due to the potential for periods of heavy thundery rain. Urban areas are most at risk, particularly where hail and wind-blown debris block drains.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of the north and east of England during Saturday due to the potential for periods of heavy thundery rain. Small and fast responding catchments are most at risk. Elsewhere, and at other times, no more than minimal river flooding impacts are expected, despite thundery showers.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
