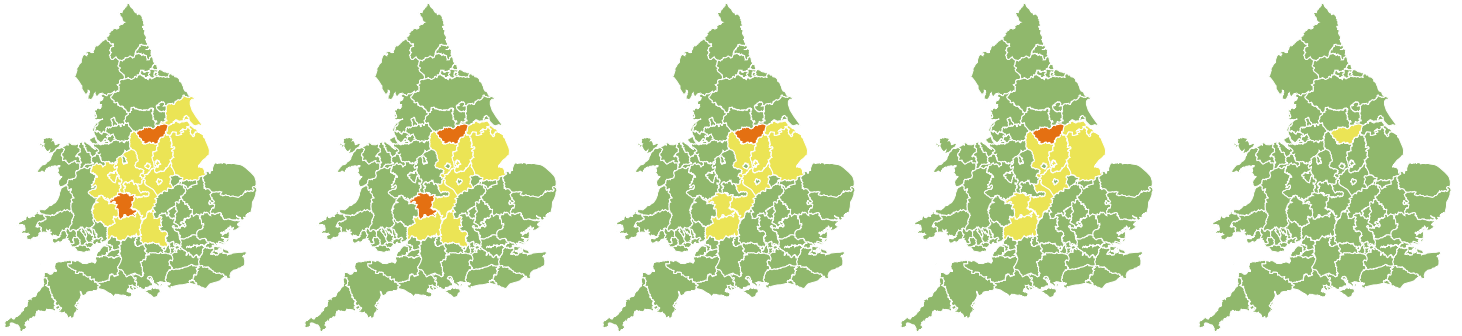

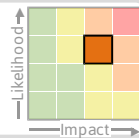

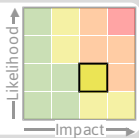

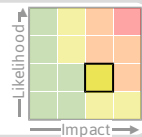

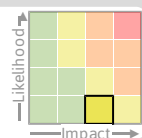

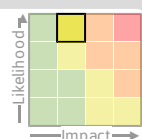

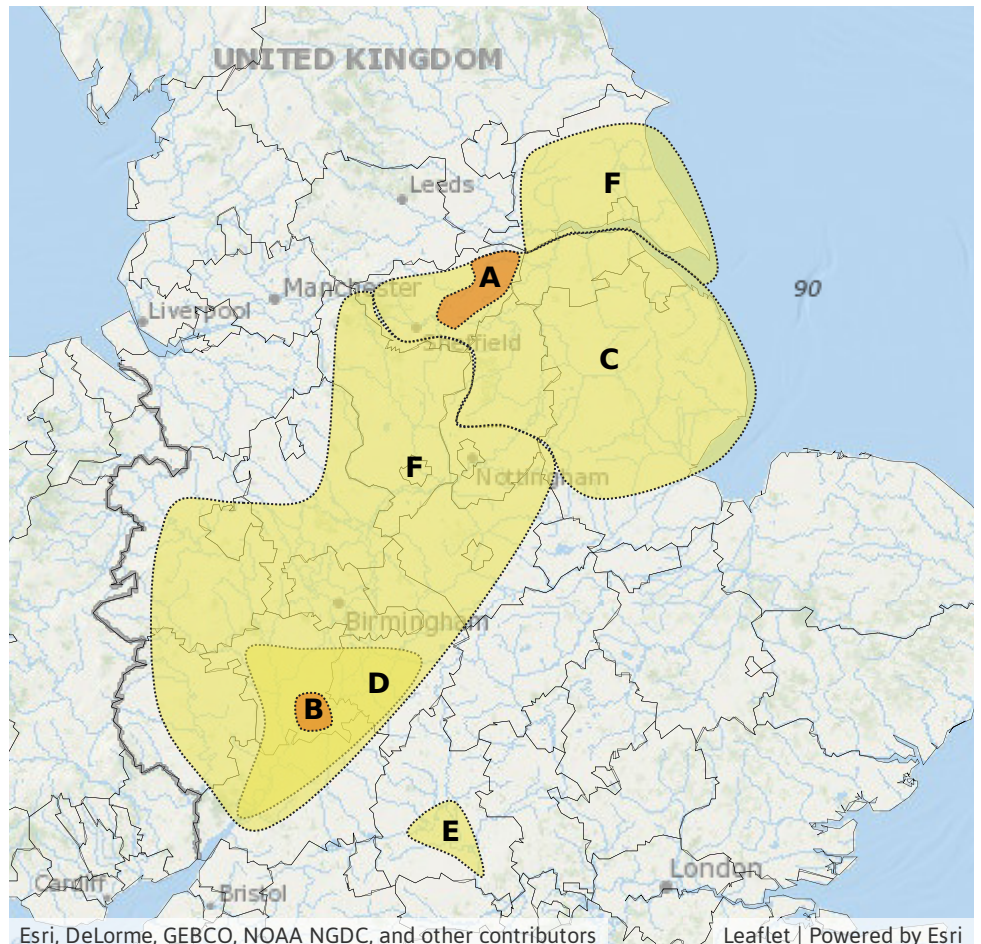

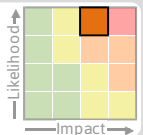

## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2: Saturday 16 to Monday 18 November 2019

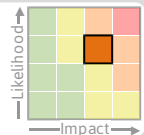

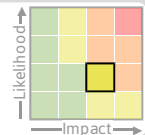

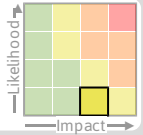

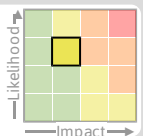

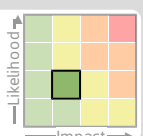

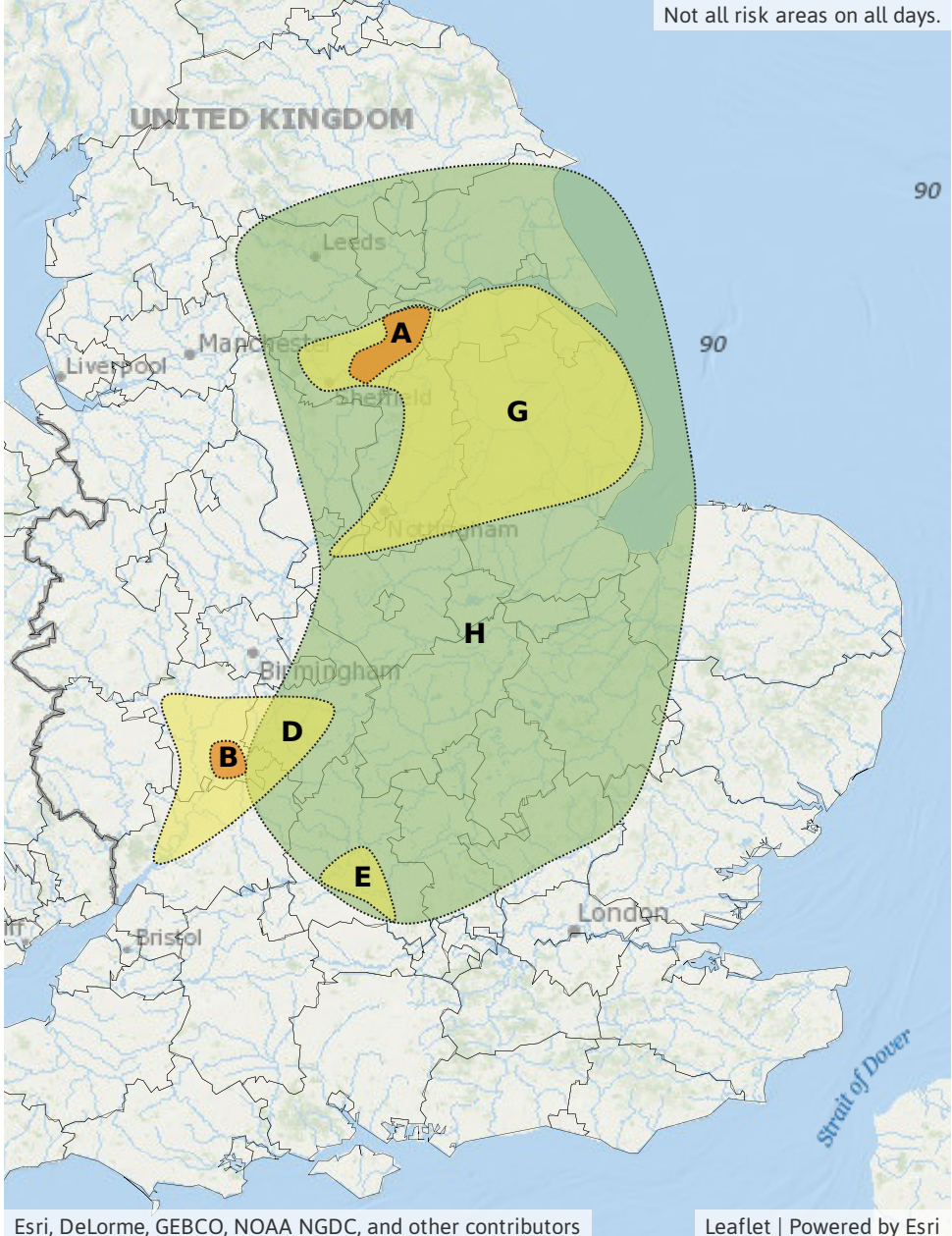

Rain falling on saturated ground could result in localised impacts on Sunday.

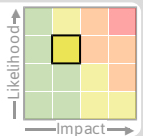

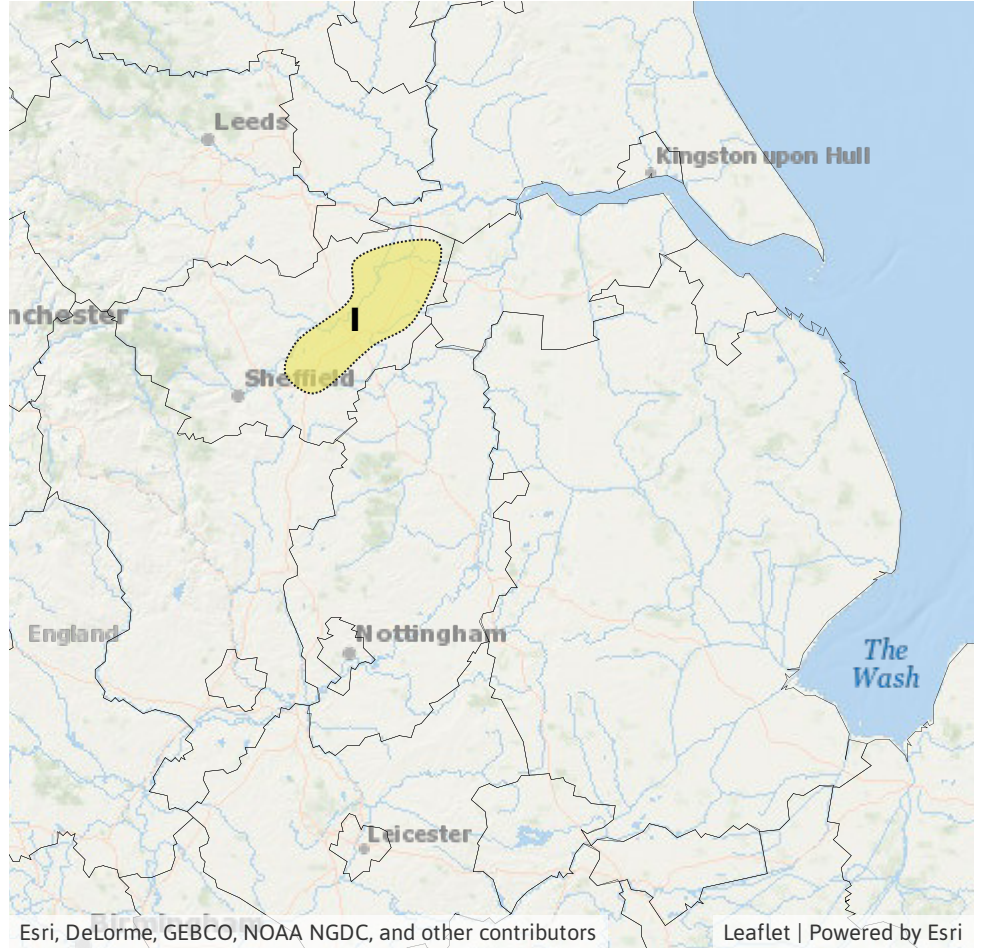
### Areas of Concern Map 3: Tuesday 19 November

**RISK AREA I**  
Impact **MINOR**  
Likelihood **MEDIUM**

Likely duration 1 + Day

Minor impacts probably continue around the lower River Don on Tuesday.



## Assessment of flood risk



### Rivers

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The overall river flood risk is MEDIUM for today (Friday) until Monday.

Ongoing significant river flooding impacts are expected in South Yorkshire around the Lower River Don until Monday, reducing to minor impacts on Tuesday. Significant river flooding impacts is also probable in Worcestershire today and tomorrow. Significant river flooding impacts are possible today elsewhere in South Yorkshire, Nottinghamshire and Lincolnshire and for parts of Gloucestershire, Worcestershire and Warwickshire today until Monday. Other significant river flooding impacts are possible but not expected in Oxfordshire today and tomorrow.

Minor river flooding is also expected to continue across other parts of the Midlands and East Yorkshire today.

Ongoing minor river flooding will probably continue to impact other parts of South Yorkshire, as well as Lincolnshire and parts of the north Midlands until Monday. Localised minor river flooding impacts are possible across other parts of the Midlands and the east and north-east of England on Sunday, due to the potential for further rain or showers to fall over catchments that are sensitive to further rainfall.



### Surface water

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The surface water flood risk is now VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding is possible across parts of the east and north-east of England and the Midlands on Sunday due to the potential for further rain falling on already saturated ground.



### Groundwater

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The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible but not expected in Lincolnshire and North Lincolnshire during the next five days.



### Coastal/Tidal

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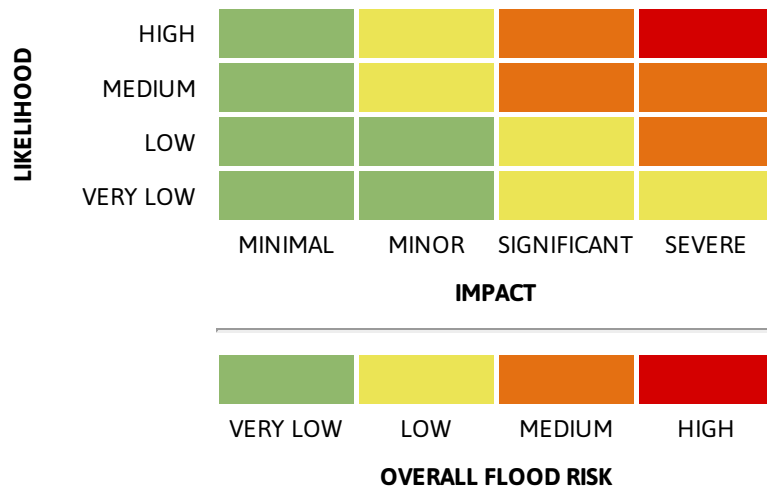
The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Strong winds and large waves may lead to isolated instances of wind-blown spray and wave overtopping this afternoon and evening along the north-east coast of England.

### 6-10 day forecast

Periods of rain and showers next week may lead to further inland flooding impacts if they fall over saturated catchments.

### Summary of potential impacts

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
