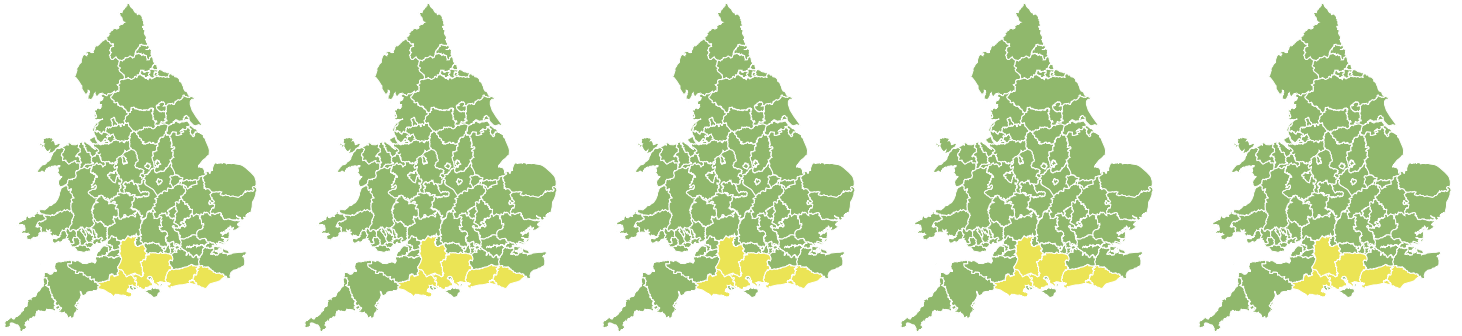

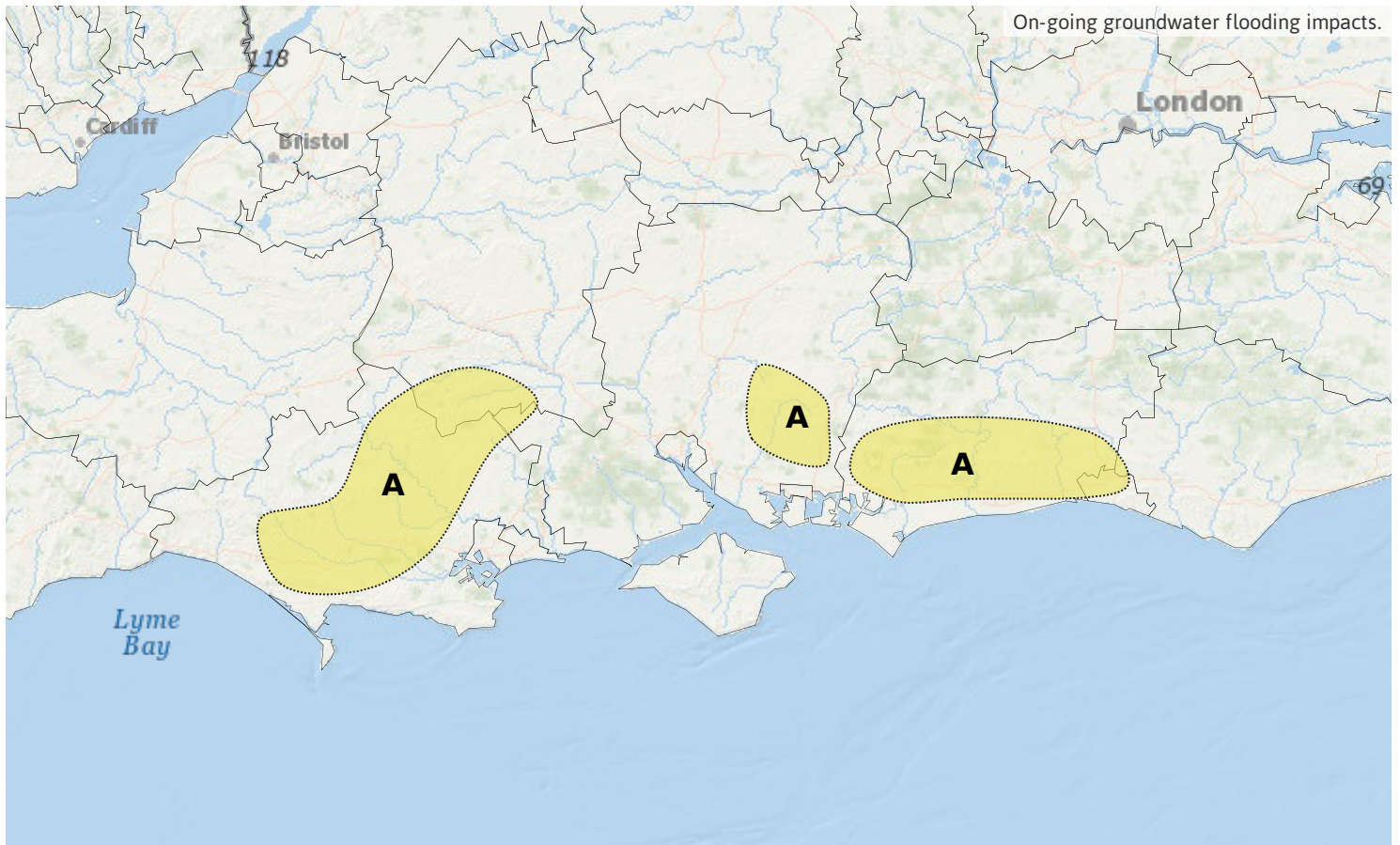
Minor groundwater flooding impacts expected to continue in parts of the south of England for the next five days. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Specific Areas of Concern Map 1: Friday 27 to Tuesday 31 December 2019

Local groundwater flooding for at least the next five days.



Assessment of flood risk



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is LOW for the next five days.

Local minor groundwater flooding impacts are expected to continue in parts of the south of England for at least the next five days, where groundwater levels continue to rise following recent rainfall. Groundwater levels are also high in North Lincolnshire, although impacts here are currently minimal.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
