Isolated minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected on Thursday. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

## Assessment of flood risk



### Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Despite locally heavy showers today (Sunday), no more than minimal impacts are expected.

Local minor flooding impacts from surface water are possible but not expected in places on Thursday. This is due to the chance of isolated heavy thunderstorms developing somewhere across England and Wales, although where exactly at this lead time is subject to uncertainty.



### Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days, despite the chance of some locally heavy showers and thunderstorms today and on Thursday.



### Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



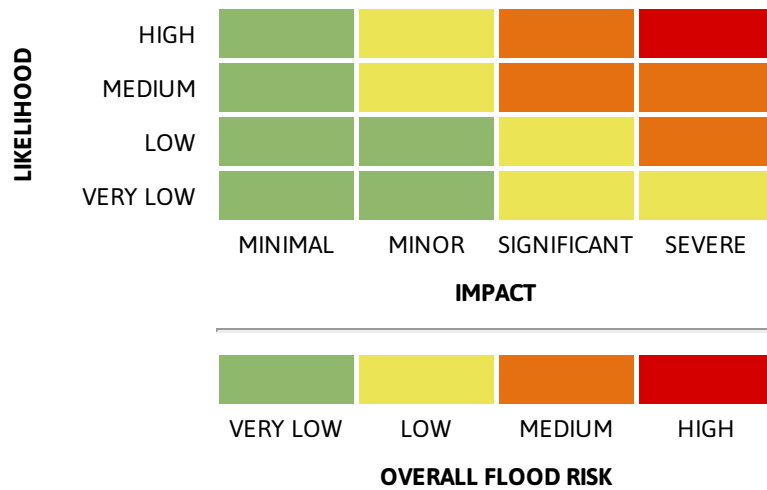
### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

### 6-10 day forecast

The risk of localised surface water impacts due to thunderstorms continues into Friday and perhaps Saturday, although this is very low confidence.

### Summary of potential impacts

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
