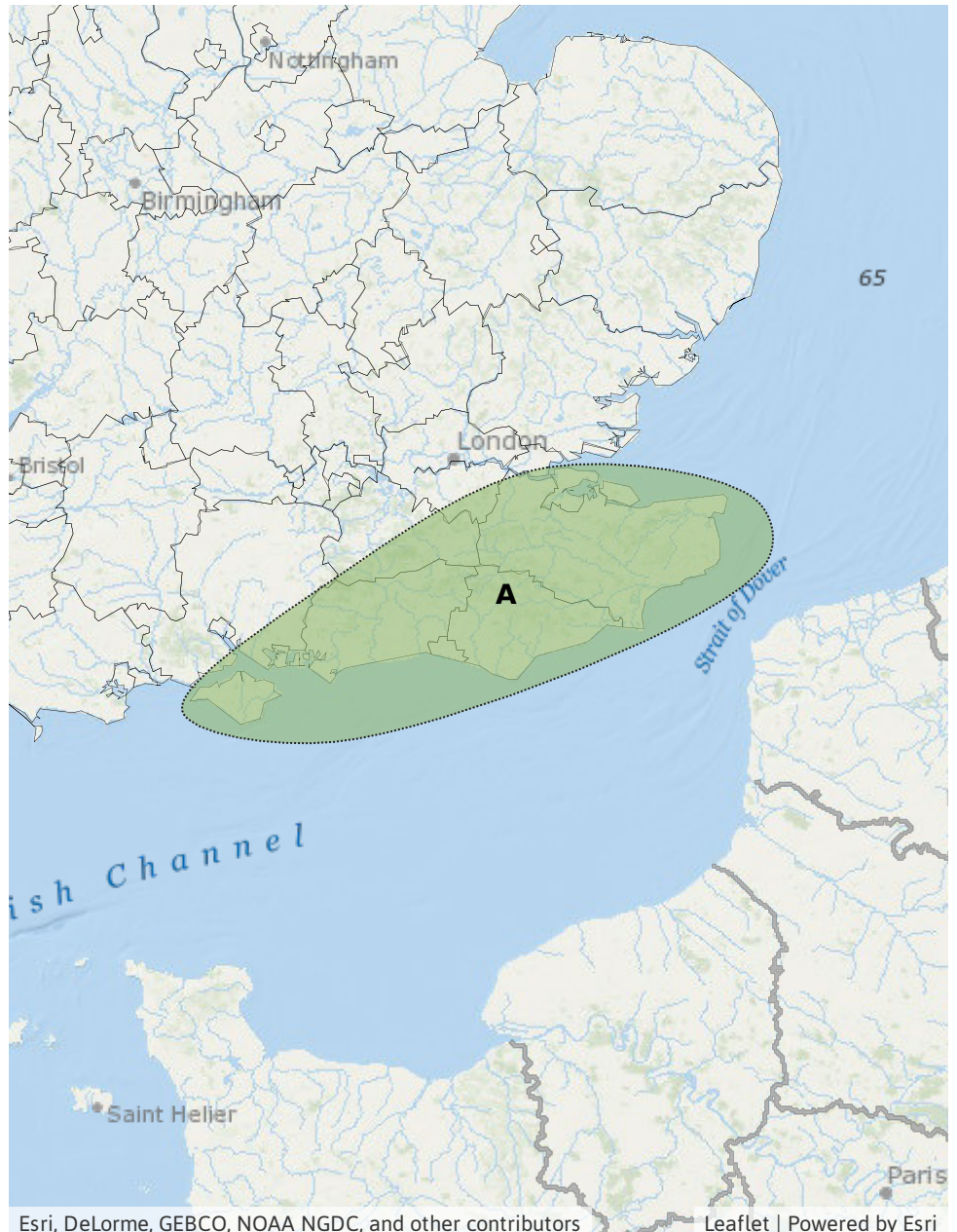
Specific Area of Concern Map 1: Sunday 25 October 2020.

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible in parts of the south east of England today (Sunday) as showers feed from the coast over ground saturated by last nights rainfall. Minor surface water impacts are possible but not expected in Wales and the north and west of England on Thursday due to heavy and persistent rainfall. Any impacts will likely continue into Friday.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible in parts of the south east of England today (Sunday) as showers feed from the coast over ground saturated by last nights rainfall. Minor river impacts are possible but not expected in Wales and the north and west of England on Thursday due to heavy and persistent rainfall. Any impacts will likely continue into Friday.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
