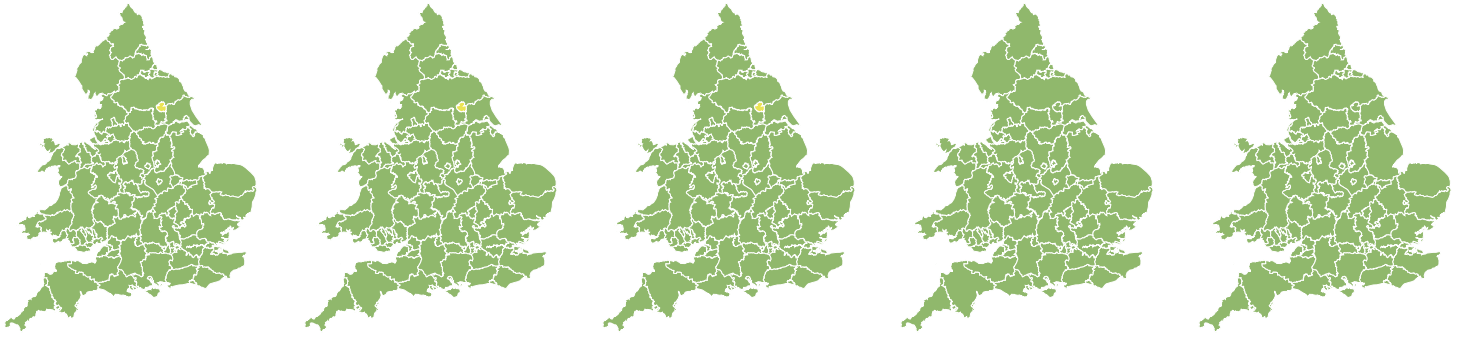

Ongoing minor river flooding impacts are expected along parts of the River Ouse in York until Friday and are possible in other parts of Yorkshire until Thursday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

## Specific Areas of Concern Map 1: Wednesday 4 to Friday 6 November 2020

**RISK AREA A**  
Impact **MINOR**  
Likelihood **HIGH**

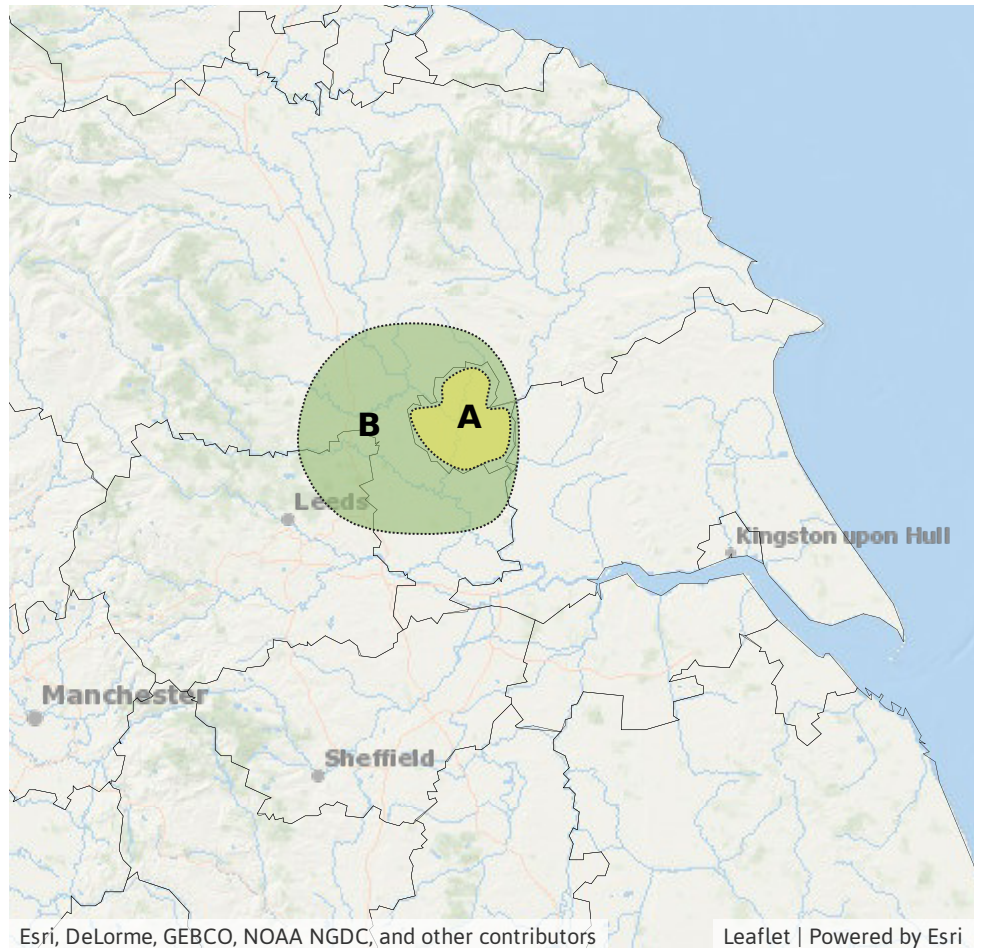
Source River  
Likely duration 3 Days

Ongoing flooding impacts in York from the River Ouse until Friday.

**RISK AREA B**  
Impact **MINOR**  
Likelihood **LOW**

Source River  
Likely duration 2 Days

Ongoing river flooding until Thursday but risk decreasing.



### Assessment of flood risk



#### Rivers

---

The river flood risk is LOW until Friday.

Ongoing minor river flooding impacts are expected along parts of the River Ouse around York until Friday. Also, minor river flooding impacts continue to be possible over other parts of Yorkshire until Thursday. This is due to river levels remaining high following the recent wet weather.



#### Surface water

---

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



#### Coastal/Tidal

---

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



#### Groundwater

---

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

## Summary of potential impacts

### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
