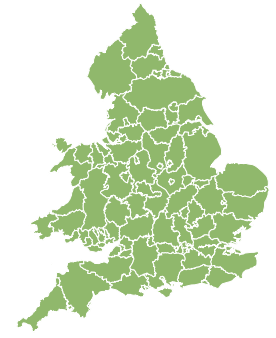


# Flood Guidance Statement

Minor coastal/tidal flooding impacts are possible today (Monday) and tomorrow in the north of England. Minor river and surface water impacts are possible but not expected in north-west England today and tomorrow. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

## Assessment of flood risk



### Coastal/Tidal

---

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW today (Monday) and on Tuesday.

Minor coastal/tidal flooding impacts are possible today and Tuesday along parts of the north-east and north-west of England coasts. Minor coastal/tidal impacts are also possible but not expected today around the Bristol Channel.

On Thursday, minor impacts are possible but not expected along the east coast of England.

This is due to high tides and large waves at times.



### Rivers

---

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of the north-west of England this evening (Monday) and into Tuesday.



### Surface water

---

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across parts of the north-west of England this evening (Monday) and into Tuesday.



### Groundwater

---

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

## Summary of potential impacts

### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
