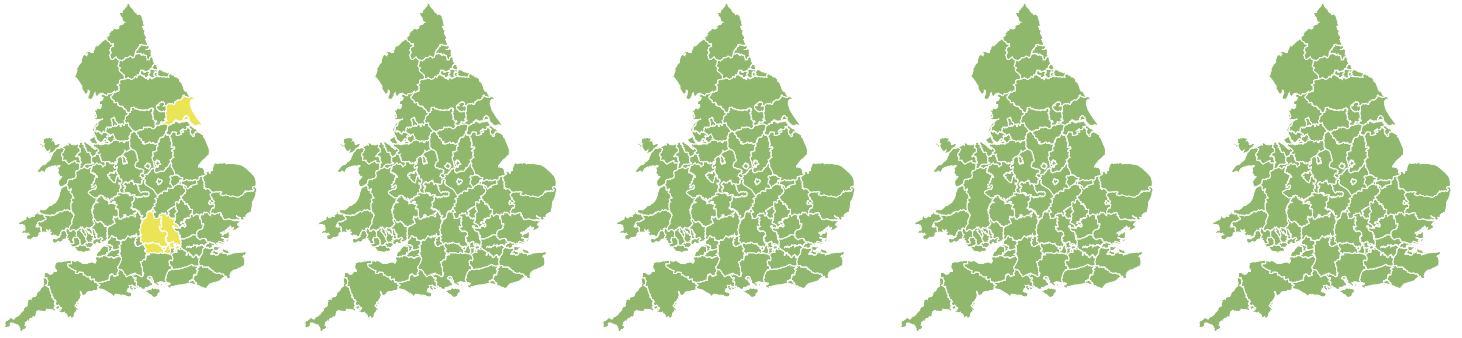

Likelihood **HIGH**

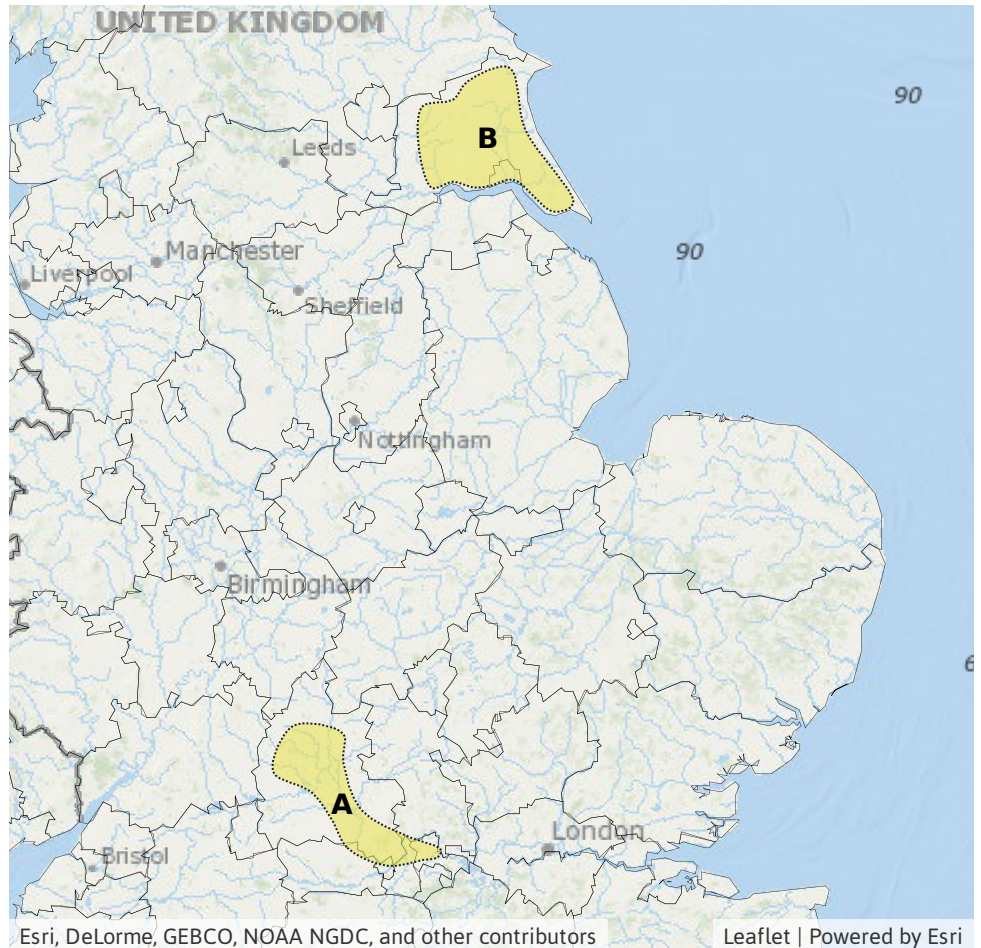

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW for today (Wednesday).

During today (Wednesday) ongoing minor river flooding impacts are expected for parts of the River Thames, and are probable in parts of Yorkshire. The overall flood risk is LOW for today.

Rain and possibly some snow melt in the south-west of England and south Wales on Sunday will be kept under review but is not currently expected to lead to more than minimal river flooding impacts.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

However, groundwater levels are high in many parts of the country, particularly in North Yorkshire and the East Riding of Yorkshire as well as parts of the south and east of England.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Rain and possible snow melt in the south-west of England and south Wales on Sunday will be kept under review but is not currently expected to lead to more than minimal surface water flooding impacts.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
