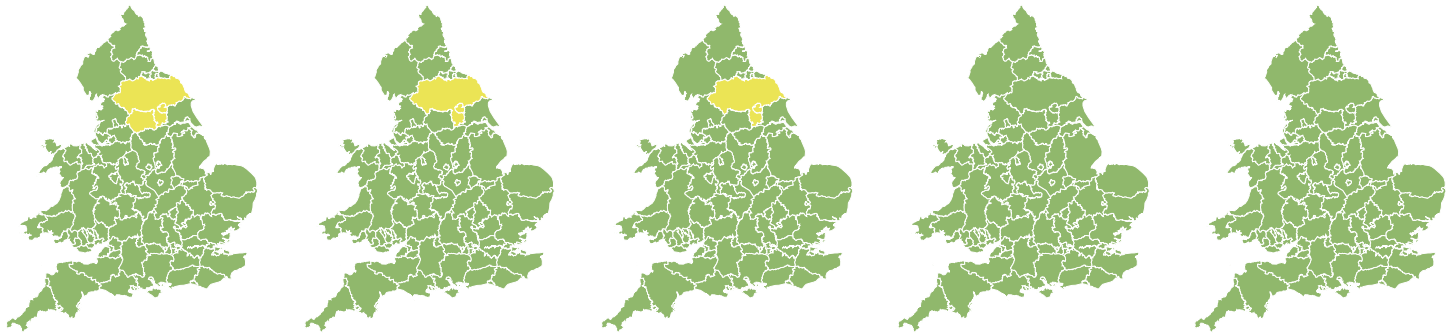

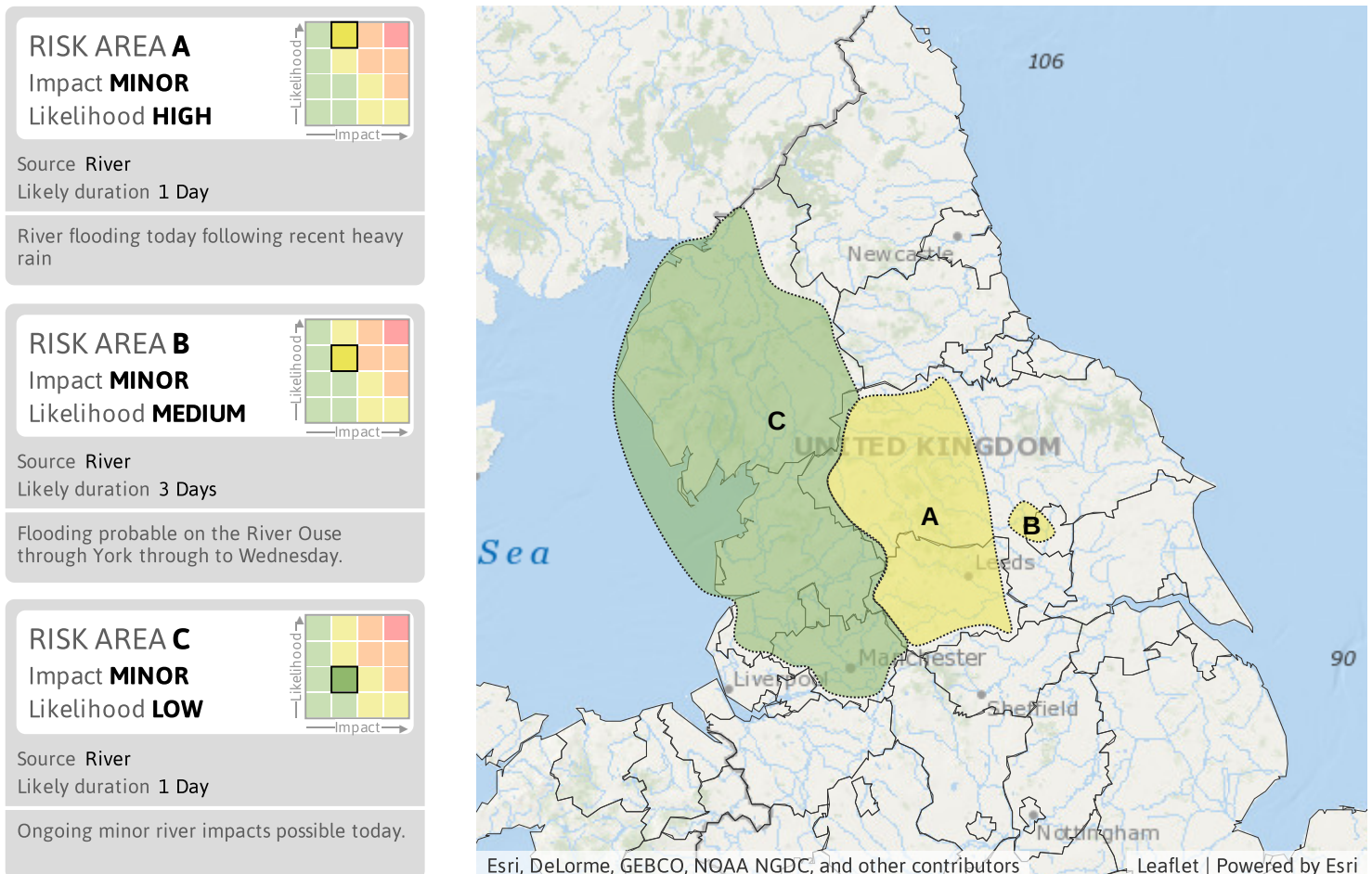

Ongoing inland flooding impacts are expected across parts of northern England today (Monday) and probable through to Wednesday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW for today (Monday) until Wednesday.

Due to continued river response resulting from recent rainfall, minor river flooding impacts are expected today (Monday) and probable through to Wednesday. Refer to Specific Areas of Concern maps for details. Some ongoing minimal river flooding impacts are also expected through parts of Wales and south-west England today.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected for coastal counties in the south-east of England late today and into Tuesday due to possible further spells of heavy rain and showers.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected for coastal counties in the south-east of England late today and into Tuesday due to possible further spells of heavy rain and showers.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days, despite some isolated instances of wave over-topping and wind blown spray at times and high spring tides towards the end of the period.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
