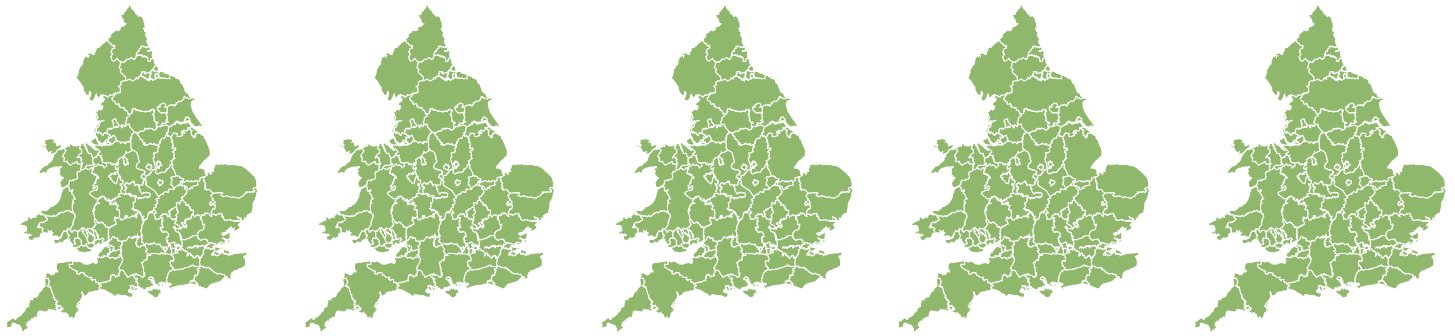

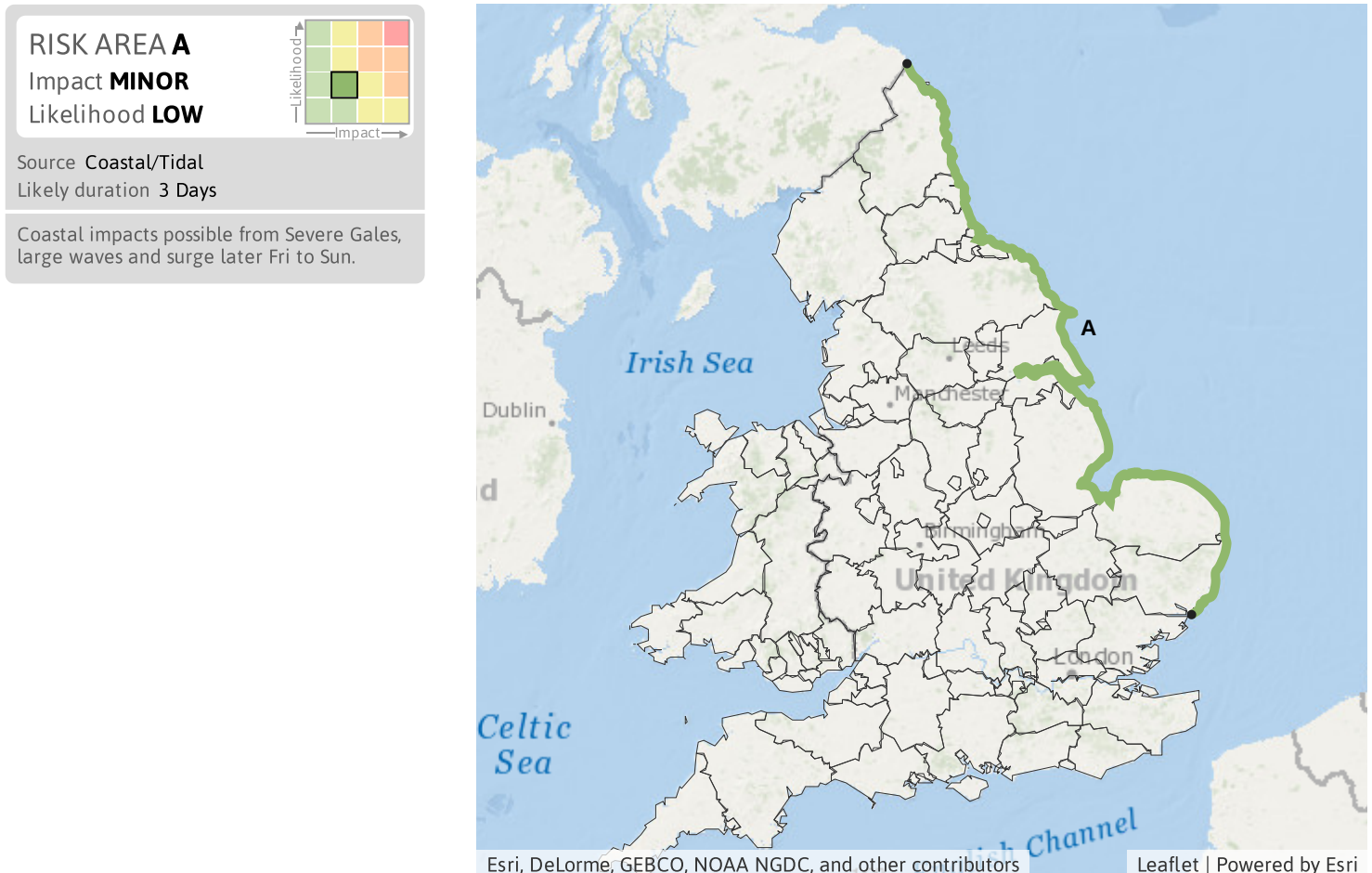

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible for parts of the east coast from later Friday to early Sunday due to Storm Arwen. The overall flood risk for England and Wales for the next five days is VERY LOW.

Assessment of flood risk

Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Storm Arwen will affect parts of the UK on Friday and Saturday. As a result there is the potential for severe coastal gales, large waves and a storm surge to lead to local minor coastal flooding impacts for parts of the east coast from later Friday to early Sunday. Some local minimal impacts are also possible for exposed parts of the west coast of England and Wales on Friday and Saturday. Astronomical tide heights are low which will mitigate against any higher impacts.

Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days, despite locally heavy rain at times from Friday to Sunday.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days, despite locally heavy rain at times from Friday to Sunday.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
