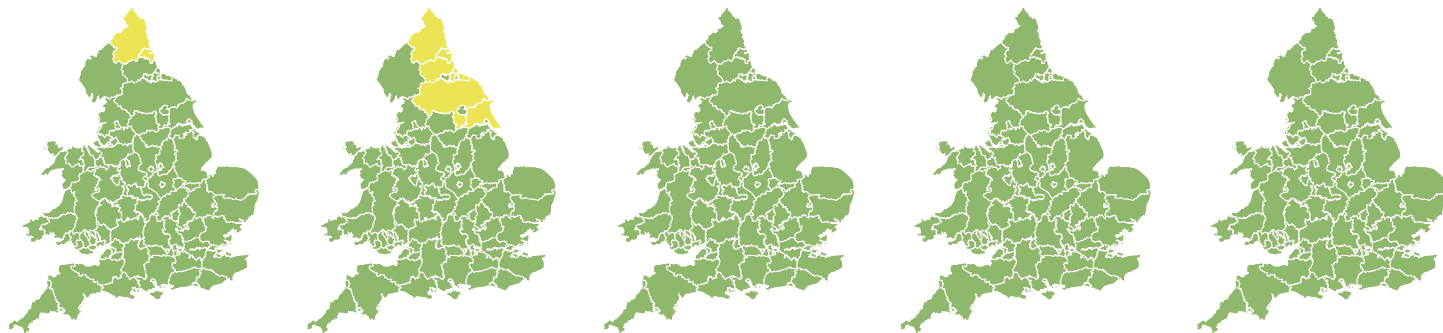


Flood Guidance Statement

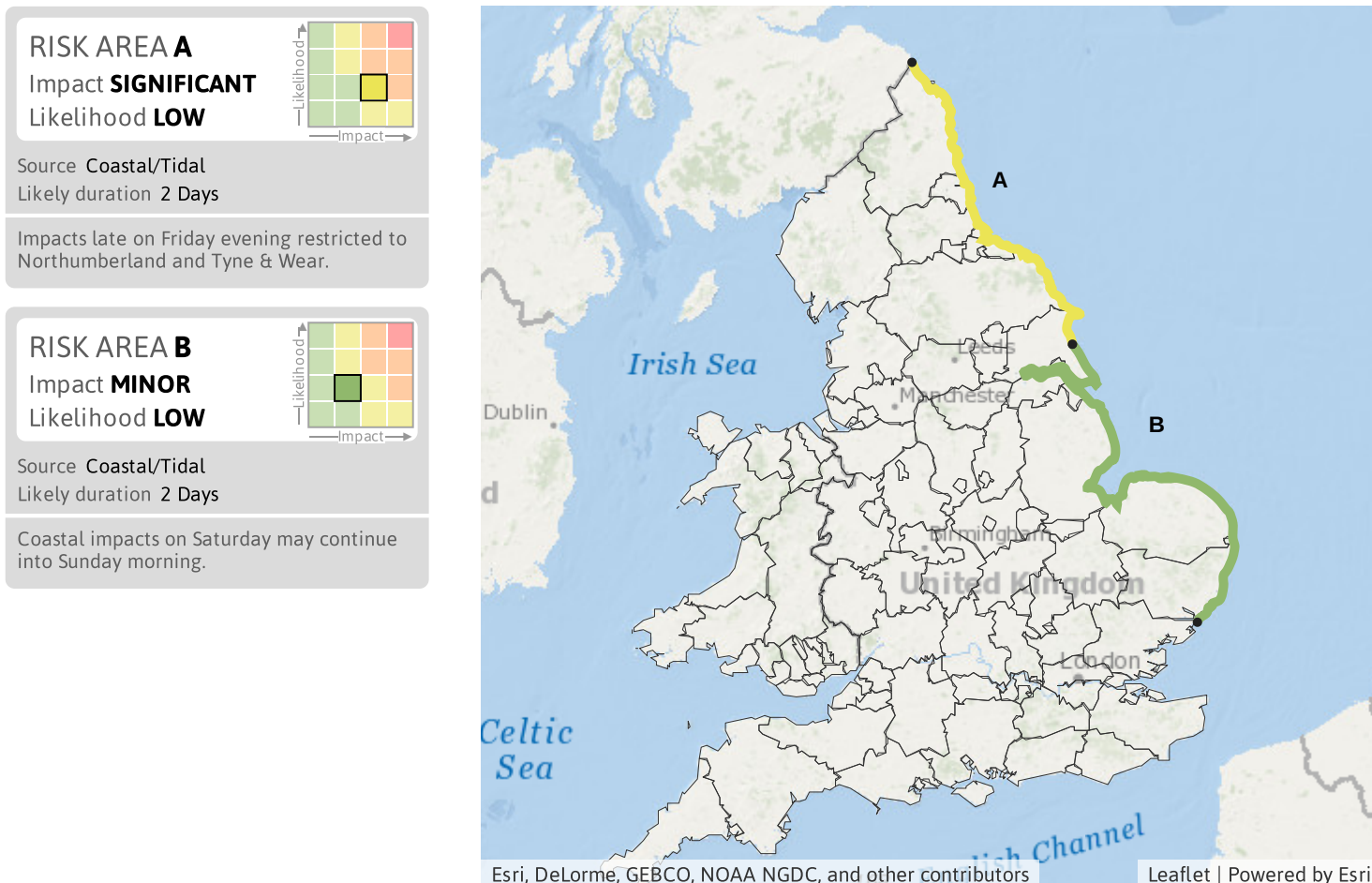

Significant coastal flooding impacts are possible for parts of the North Sea coast late on Friday and during Saturday due to Storm Arwen. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Assessment of flood risk

Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is **LOW** late on Friday and during Saturday.

Storm Arwen will affect parts of the UK from today (Friday) until early on Sunday. Winds are expected to reach Storm Force around some coasts, resulting in very large waves. Wave over-topping may lead to local significant coastal flooding impacts for parts of the north-east and Yorkshire coasts of England late on Friday and during Saturday. Astronomical tide heights are low which will mitigate against any higher impacts. Minor impacts are possible elsewhere on the east coast of England on Saturday into early Sunday. Some local minimal impacts are also possible for exposed parts of the west coast of England and the north and west coasts of Wales today (Friday) and on Saturday.

Rivers

The river flood risk is **VERY LOW** for the next five days, despite locally heavy rain at times from today (Friday) until Sunday.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is **VERY LOW** for the next five days, despite locally heavy rain at times from today (Friday) until Sunday.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is **VERY LOW** for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
