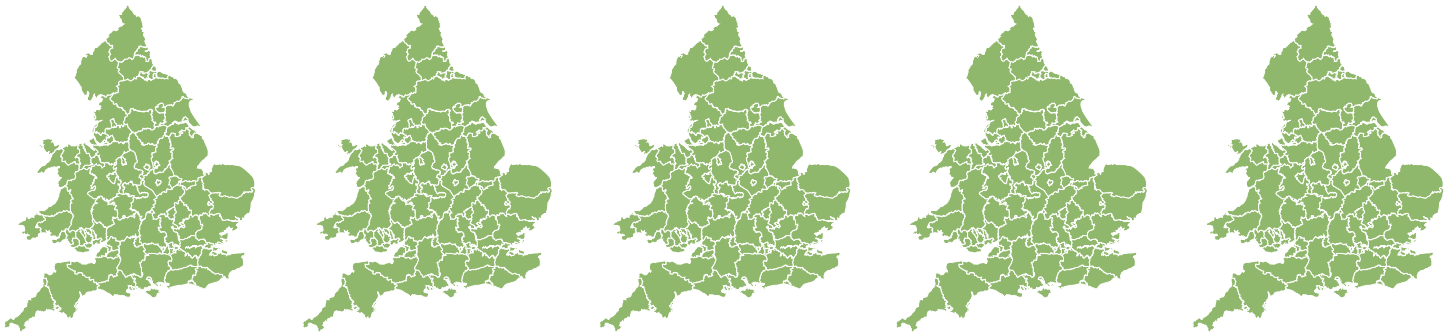

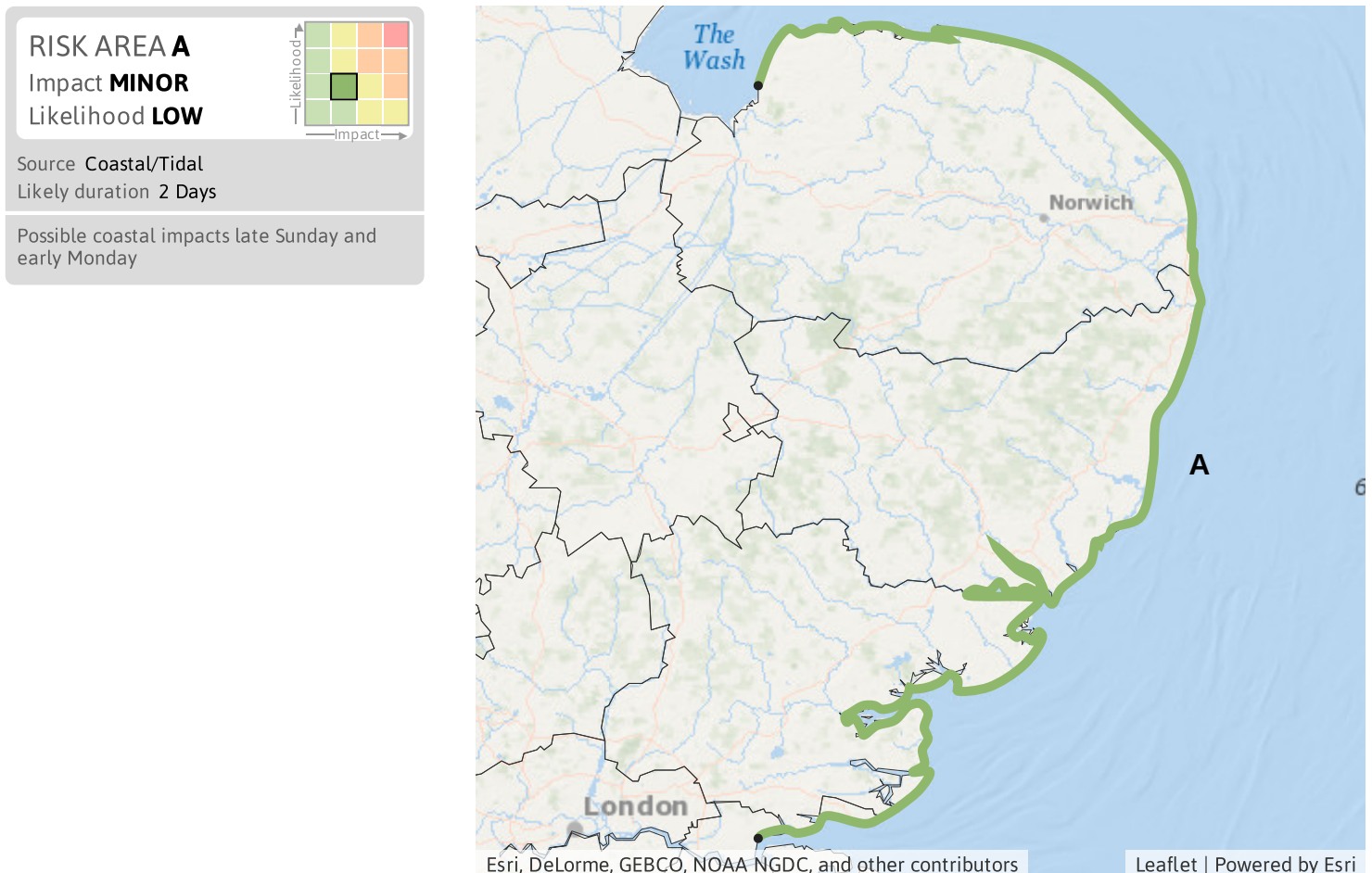

The overall flood risk for England and Wales for the next five days is VERY LOW. Localised minor coastal flooding impacts are possible along parts of the coast of East Anglia today (Sunday) and tomorrow (Monday) morning.

## Assessment of flood risk

### Coastal/Tidal

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The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Localised coastal flooding impacts are possible along parts of the coast of East Anglia today (Sunday) and tomorrow (Monday) morning - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Coastal flooding impacts are also possible but not expected elsewhere along the east coast at times today.

This is due to large surge, strong winds and wave action at times today and tomorrow morning.

### Rivers

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The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Localised minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected today (Sunday) across parts of the north of England, the Midlands and Wales following heavy rain during Saturday night/Sunday morning. Rivers will remain high in places and catchments sensitive to further rainfall today.

### Surface water

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The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

### Groundwater

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The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

### Summary of potential impacts

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads  
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades  
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads  
Flooding affecting individual properties  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities  
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures  
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel  
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities  
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure  
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
