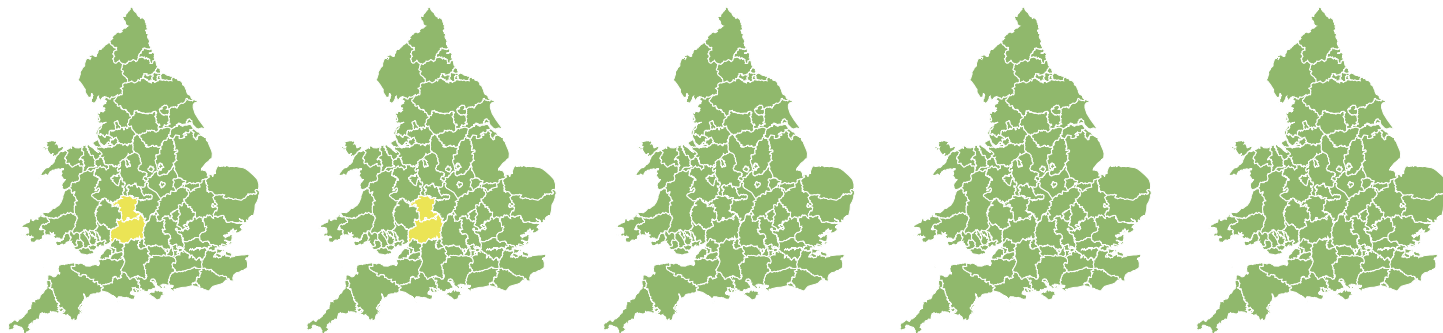


Flood Guidance Statement

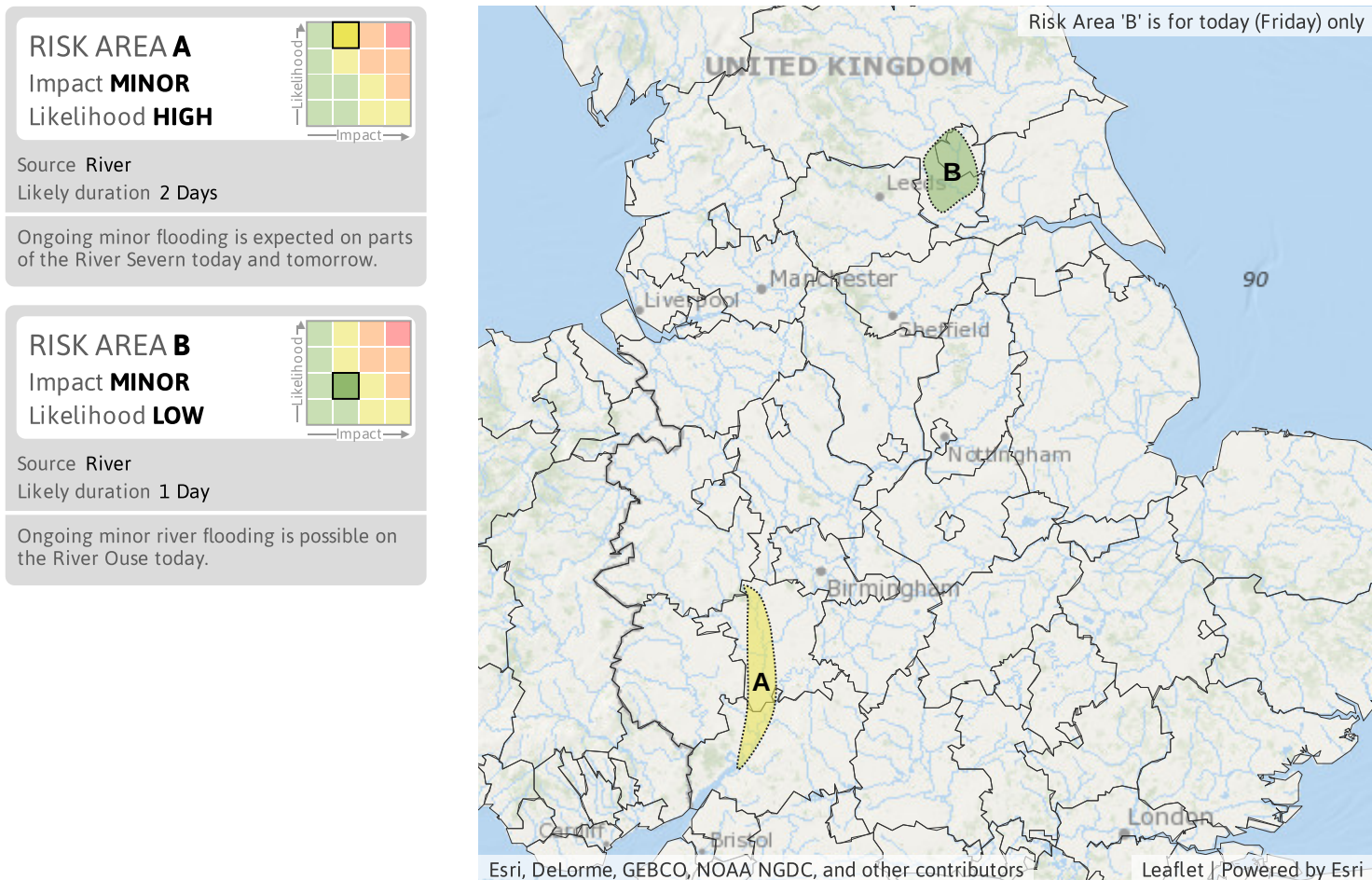

Minor river flooding impacts are expected along the River Severn today and tomorrow and are possible in parts of the north of England today. Inland flooding impacts are possible but not expected in England and Wales on Monday. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW today (Friday) and tomorrow.

Persistent, heavy rain that fell on Sunday continues to cause high water levels in some larger river catchments. Minor river flooding impacts are expected to continue on the lower River Severn today and tomorrow and are still possible in the north of England through today. See Specific Areas of Concern Map for details.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected across Wales and for parts of the north and the west of England on Monday. This is due to heavy and persistent rainfall falling on wet ground.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected across Wales and for parts of the north and the west of England on Monday. This is due to heavy and persistent rainfall.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
