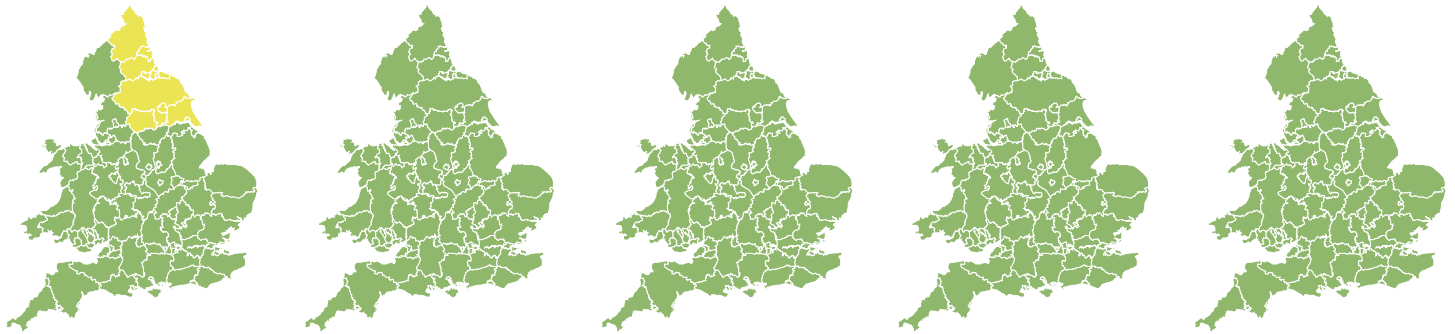

Minor inland flooding impacts are probable in parts of the North of England today and possible elsewhere as rivers respond to recent rain. The overall flood risk is LOW.

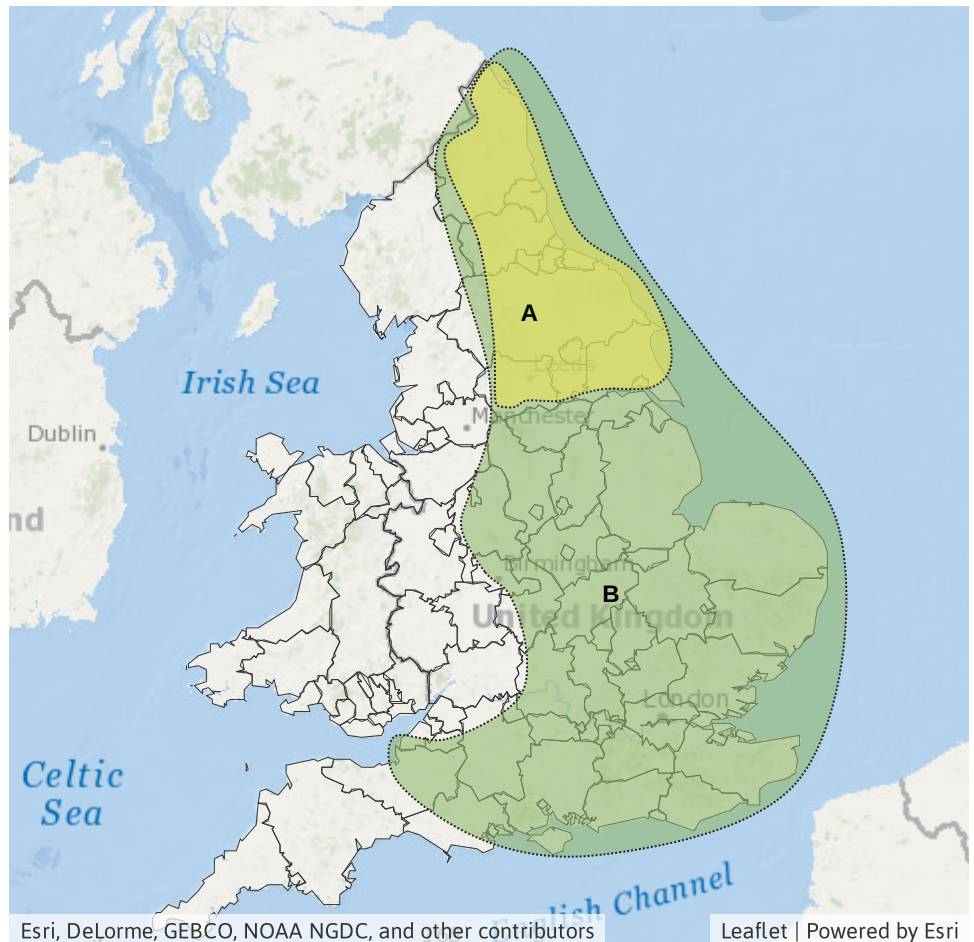

Assessment of flood risk



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW today (Friday).

Minor river flooding impacts are probable in parts of the North East of England, Yorkshire and the Humber today, and possible more widely as rivers continue to respond to recent rainfall (See Specific Areas of Concern Map).

Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of the North of England on Sunday and more widely across England and Wales on Monday with potential for further rain on sensitive catchments.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW today and for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of the North of England on Sunday and more widely across England and Wales on Monday with the potential for multiple spells of heavy rain.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
