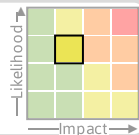
Minor inland flooding impacts are probable across parts of the south of Wales and the south of England today (Saturday) into tomorrow. The overall flood risk is LOW.

RISK AREA B

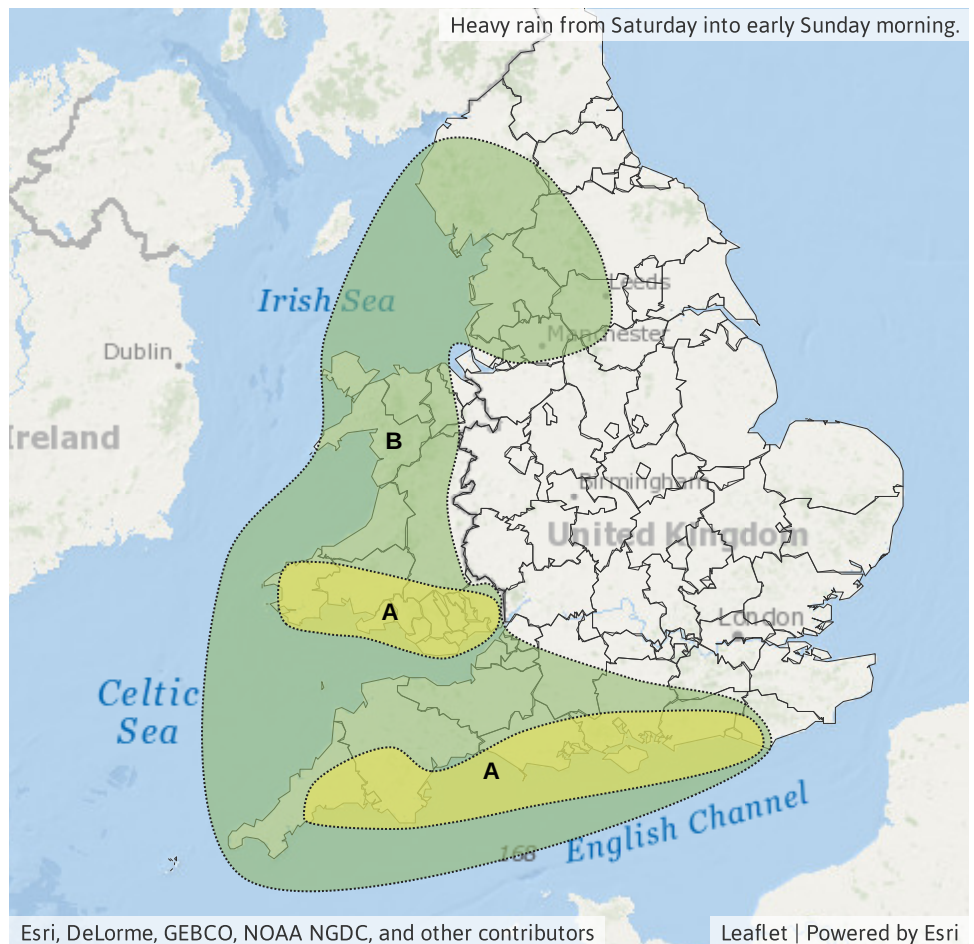
Impact **MINOR**

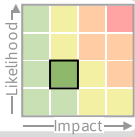

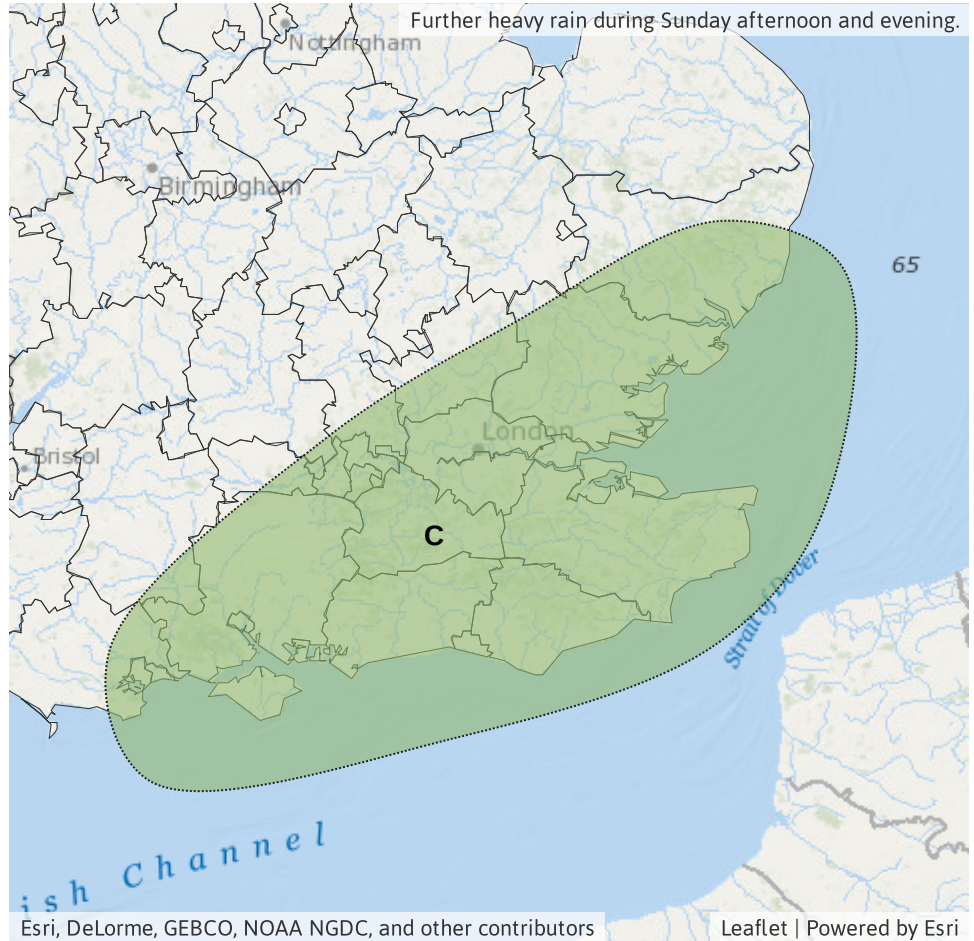
Specific Areas of Concern Map 2: Sunday 27 and Monday 28 November 2022

Likelihood **LOW**



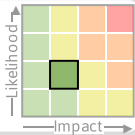
Source River Surface

Further heavy rainfall is possible later on Sunday. Rivers only on Monday.



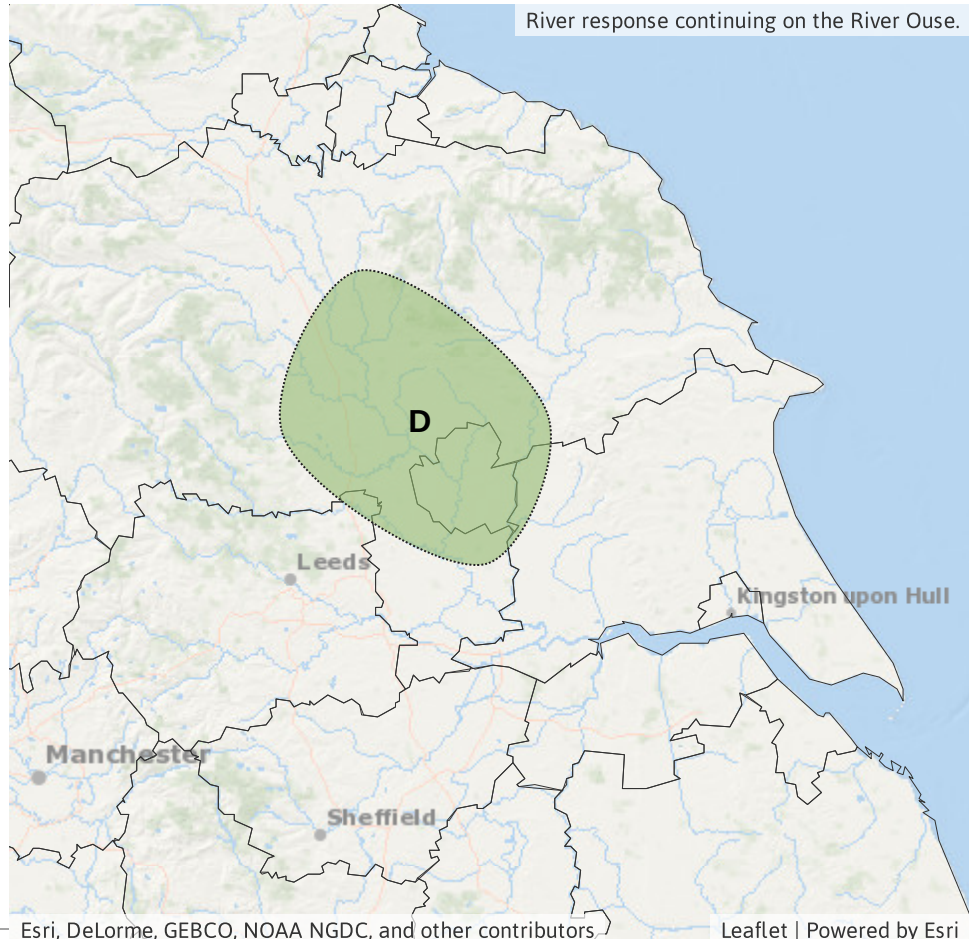
Specific Areas of Concern Map 3: Monday 28 November 2022

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Saturday) and on Sunday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable in parts of England and Wales today and tomorrow. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps for details. Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected more widely in England and Wales on both days.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW from today (Saturday) and on Sunday.

Minor river flooding impacts are probable for parts of England and Wales for today and tomorrow, and possible into Monday. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps for details. Minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected more widely across England and Wales during this time.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



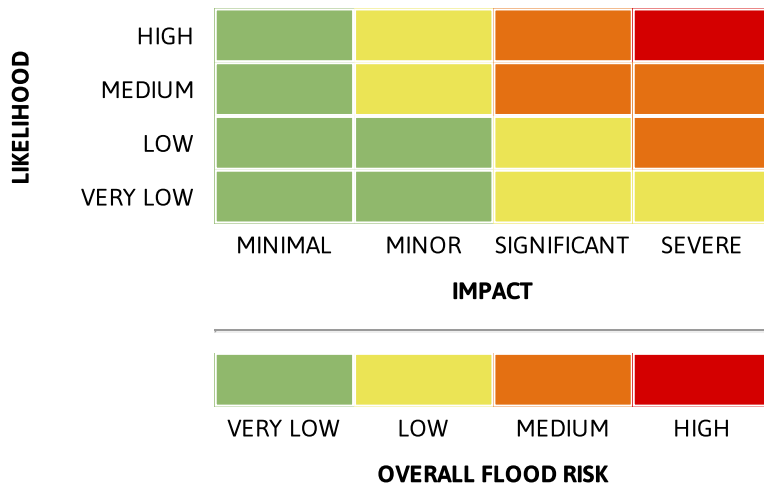
Groundwater

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads
Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads
Flooding affecting individual properties
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel
Widespread flooding affecting whole communities
Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure
Large scale evacuation of properties possible
