


Localised minor surface water flooding impacts are possible for parts of England and Wales tomorrow (Wednesday). The overall flood risk for England and Wales is VERY LOW for the next five days.

### Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Localised minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of England and Wales on Wednesday. See Specific Area of Concern map for details. This is due to isolated heavy thundery showers which may be slow moving at times.

Localised minor surface water flooding is also possible but not expected more widely on Wednesday in the North East of England due to rain and showers.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



# Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



# Summary of potential impacts

### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
