


Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected later today (Friday) and early Saturday in parts of England. The overall flood risk is LOW.










Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 18th August 2023 (Morning)

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW for today (Friday) and Saturday.

Significant surface water flooding impacts are possible but not expected later today and early Saturday over parts of England. Prior to this, local minor surface water flooding impacts are possible this morning across parts of the Midlands and South of England. This is due to the potential for thunderstorms and heavy rain. See Areas of Concern Maps.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Local minor river flooding impacts are possible but not expected later Friday and into Saturday morning over parts of England. This is due to the potential for heavy rain and thunderstorms. See Areas of Concern Map 1.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
