



Minor surface water flooding is probable for parts of Wales and South West England later today (Thursday). Minor inland flooding impacts are probable across parts of England and Wales during Friday. The overall flood risk is LOW.








Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 13 October

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW today (Thursday) and tomorrow (Friday).

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable from Thursday evening, with the risk extending more widely across England and Wales during Friday as heavy rain spreads north and east. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW on Friday.

Minor river flooding impacts are probable on Friday across parts of England and Wales and possible more widely due to widespread and locally heavy rainfall. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Ongoing minor river flooding may continue into the weekend across parts of England and Wales.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
