


Minor coastal impacts are probable today (Friday) and on Saturday in the Norfolk Broads. Minor inland flooding impacts are probable across the South of England on Saturday, with river impacts into Sunday in SE England. The overall flood risk is LOW.





Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Saturday 04 November 2023






















Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Sunday 5 November 2023

Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable for parts of the South of England due to rain and heavy showers on Saturday, and are possible across the Midlands and South Wales. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is LOW.

High water levels will affect the Norfolk Broads today (Friday) and on Saturday due to recent rainfall and high tides. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



Rivers

The river flood risk is LOW.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible today (Friday) across parts of England in response to rain from Storm Ciaran.

Minor river flooding impacts are probable in parts of South East England later on Saturday and into Sunday due to further rain and showers falling on sensitive catchments, with possible impacts across the rest of the South of England too.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible but not expected from Friday in parts of Dorset and Wiltshire and from Sunday in parts of West Sussex as groundwater levels increase following recent heavy rainfall.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
