



Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable on Saturday, with minor groundwater impacts possible into next week across parts of the South of England. The overall flood risk is LOW.









## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 November

### Assessment of flood risk



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW on Saturday.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable across southern parts of England and Wales from the early hours of Saturday due to heavy rain - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are also possible across parts of Mid Wales, and possible but not expected across parts of the North West of England, on Saturday and Sunday, due to spells of heavy rain and showers - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Rivers

The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible across southern parts of England and Wales on Saturday due to heavy rain falling on wet catchments - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible across parts of Mid Wales, and possible but not expected across parts of the North West of England, on Saturday and Sunday as further rain and showers fall on sensitive catchments - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.



### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible for the next five days across parts of Dorset and West Sussex (see Specific Areas of Concern Map), and are possible but not expected in Wiltshire. This is due to recent heavy rainfall and on-going unsettled conditions.



### Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



## **Summary of potential impacts**

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
