


Minor river and surface water flooding impacts are possible today (Saturday) and tomorrow for parts of England and Wales with minor groundwater flooding possible into next week in parts of the South of England. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.




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## Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Saturday 18 to Wednesday 22 November 2023

Localised minor flooding from groundwater possible through the next five days.



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## Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible across parts of the South of England and South Wales today (Saturday) following heavy rain on wet catchments - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible across parts of Mid Wales, and are possible but not expected across parts of North West England, today and tomorrow, as further outbreaks of rain and showers fall on sensitive catchments - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.



# Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of the South East of England today (Saturday) following heavy rain - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible across parts of Mid Wales, and are possible but not expected across parts of North West England, today and tomorrow, as further outbreaks of rain and showers fall on sensitive catchments - see Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible for the next five days across parts of Dorset and West Sussex (see Specific Areas of Concern Map), and are possible but not expected in Wiltshire. This is due to recent heavy rainfall and on-going unsettled conditions.



The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

# Summary of potential impacts

### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
