


Minor groundwater flooding is possible through to Friday across parts of the South of England. Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected for parts of the East of England coast on Friday. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

Assessment of flood risk



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible from today (Wednesday) through to Friday across parts of Dorset and West Sussex (see Specific Areas of Concern Map), and are possible but not expected in Wiltshire. This is due to recent heavy rainfall.

🖸 Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected along parts of the coasts of Norfolk, Suffolk and Essex during Friday as a storm surge and large waves coincide with high tides.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
