


Minor groundwater flooding is possible through to Friday in parts of the South of England. Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible for parts of the Essex coast and possible but not expected on East of England coasts on Friday. The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.








Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday evening 24 November 2023

Assessment of flood risk



Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible today and tomorrow across parts of Dorset (see Specific Areas of Concern Map 1), and are possible but not expected in Wiltshire and in the south-east of Hampshire from Saturday. This is due to recent heavy rainfall.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible on parts of the Essex coast and possible but not expected more widely along parts of Yorkshire and East of England coasts during Friday. This is due to large surge and large waves coinciding with high tides.



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Flood risk matrix



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
