
Ongoing flooding possible along parts of the **River Severn until Sunday**





Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW.

Minor river flooding impacts are expected to continue in parts of Somerset with minor impacts possible across other parts of England. Some longer, slower responding rivers may see continued impacts in their lower reaches this weekend. See Areas of Concern Map 1.

Minor river flooding impacts are possible widely across England and Wales on Monday due to the potential for persistent, heavy rainfall. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 2.



The groundwater flood risk is LOW.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are probable in parts of West Dorset and are possible in other parts of England throughout the next five days. See Areas of Concern Maps.



Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible widely across England and Wales on Monday due to the potential for persistent, heavy rainfall. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 2.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
