
### Specific Areas of Concern Map 1 - Thursday 28 December 2023




















## Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Friday 29 December 2023














## Specific Areas of Concern Map 3 - Saturday 30 and Sunday 31 December 2023







#### Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW.

Minor river flooding is probable in the North of England and parts of the Midlands as rivers continue to respond to recent rainfall. Minor river flooding impacts may continue until Monday on larger rivers.

Minor river flooding is also possible on Saturday due to a further spell of heavy rain.

See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.



### Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are possible on Saturday due to a further spell of heavy rain. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.



### Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible across parts of the South of England and Yorkshire and the Humber throughout the next five days. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.



### Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Large waves may bring spray and overtopping onto south and west coasts of Wales and the coast of North West England today but only minimal impacts are expected.



### **Summary of potential impacts**

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades
Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### **MINOR**

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SIGNIFICANT**

Flooding affecting parts of communities
Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures
Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### **SEVERE**

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
