


Isolated significant river flooding impacts are possible for some parts of England until Thursday. Minor river and surface water impacts are also probable at times during the next 5 days in parts of England and Wales. The overall flood risk is LOW.

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

Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Wednesday 3 January 2024






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Specific Areas of Concern Map 4 - Tuesday 2 to Saturday 6 January 2024



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Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW.

Local river flooding impacts could occur in parts of England over the next five days as rivers respond to recent and forecast heavy rainfall. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is LOW.

Minor surface water flooding impacts are probable across parts of England and Wales today (Tuesday) and could occur on Thursday and Friday. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps.

Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible across parts of the South of England and Yorkshire and the Humber throughout the next five days. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.



The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
