Ongoing significant impacts along the lower River Trent and in Gloucester.





Source River Likely duration 4 Days

Ongoing minor river flooding probable from today (Sunday) to Wednesday



Ongoing minor river flooding possible today, and possible but not expected on Monday.



Likely duration 4 Days

Minor flooding impacts probable along the River Severn until Wednesday.




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Likely duration 4 Days

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Minor impacts expected on the River Thames until Wednesday.



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

Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Monday 8 January 2024



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

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Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is MEDIUM.

Ongoing flooding impacts along main rivers in England leads to elevated flood risk for the next four days following the recent period of prolonged wet weather.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible across parts of the South of England and Yorkshire and the Humber throughout the next five days. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.

Surface water

The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.



Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.


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Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
