


Minor inland flooding impacts are probable on Sunday and Monday across parts of Wales and the North of England. The overall flood risk is LOW.

Minor surface water impacts possible from heavy rain through Saturday.



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Specific Areas of Concern Map 2 - Sunday 21 and Monday 22 January 2024



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

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

Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is LOW for Sunday and Monday.

Minor river flooding impacts are probable for parts of Wales and the North of England on Sunday and Monday, and possible more widely across the North of England and Wales due to successive spells of heavy rain over the weekend and into Monday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 2.

Minor river flooding continuing through York on Tuesday and Wednesday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 3.

Minor river flooding impacts are also possible but not expected across Wales and the North of England on Tuesday due to more widespread rain.



The surface water flood risk is LOW for Sunday and Monday.

Spells of heavy rain over the weekend and into Monday could lead to localised flooding impacts across Wales and the North of England, particularly North West England. See Specific Areas of Concern Maps 1 and 2.

Further minor surface water flooding is possible but not expected across parts of Wales and the North of England on Tuesday.


Impacts could include localised flooding from urban and fast responding smaller watercourses/catchments, drains, channels and flooding from overland flow.

Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor impacts are possible across parts of the South of England and Yorkshire and the Humber.

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible on the west Dorset coast prone to south-westerly waves on Sunday and Monday. See Specific Areas of Concern Map 2.

Minor coastal flooding impacts are possible but not expected within the Norfolk Broads from Monday to Wednesday due to tide locking.


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Summary of potential impacts

MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
