



Minor river flooding impacts are possible in York today (Wednesday). The overall flood risk is VERY LOW.

### Assessment of flood risk



The river flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minor river flooding impacts continue to be possible in York today (Wednesday) following recent rain. Refer to Specific Areas of Concern map.

## Groundwater

The groundwater flood risk is VERY LOW for the next four days.

Minor groundwater flooding impacts are possible across parts of the South of England and in parts of Yorkshire and the Humber through the next three days. See Specific Areas of Concern Map.

### 🚺 Coastal/Tidal

The coastal/tidal flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

Minimal coastal impacts are expected along parts of the Essex and Suffolk coastline on Thursday morning due to storm surge. Impacts may include localised flooding of low lying roads and coastal promenades.



The surface water flood risk is VERY LOW for the next five days.

### Summary of potential impacts

#### MINIMAL

Isolated and minor flooding of low-lying land and roads Isolated spray/wave on coastal promenades Little or no disruption to travel, but wet road surfaces

#### MINOR

Localised flooding of land and roads Flooding affecting individual properties Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SIGNIFICANT

Flooding affecting parts of communities Possible danger to life and damage to buildings/structures Disruption to travel and key sites in flood plans

#### SEVERE

Danger to life, severe disruption to travel Widespread flooding affecting whole communities Widespread disruption or loss of infrastructure Large scale evacuation of properties possible
